

Sec. 8321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest. additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable p together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in Tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to teach market

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien mposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Hability for the amount so secood (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of M

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security In-esis, Meghanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The Hen imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which makes the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the agreetary.
