The Index is the NATIONAL MONTHLY AVERAGE COST OF FUNDS TO FSLIC INSURED SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS, FEDERAL HOME LOAN BANK BOARD. The most recent Index figure available as of 45 days before each Change Date is called the "Current Index."

If the index is no longer available, the Note Holder will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. The Note Holder will give me notice of its choice.

(C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest rate by adding . . . TWO AND ONE-HALF . . . percentage points (. . . 2.5 . . . %) to the Current Index. The sum will be my new interest rate. THE INTEREST RATE WILL NOT BE INCREASED OR DECREASED BY MORE THAN .2 PERCENTAGE POINTS ANNUALLY, BEGINNING WITH THE FIRST ADJUSTMENT, OR 6 . . . % OVER THE LIFE OF THE LOAN.

(E) Notice of Changes

The Note Holder will mail or deliver to me a notice before each Change Date. The notice will advise me of:

- (i) the new interest rate on my loan as of the Change Date;
- (ii) the amount of my monthly payment following the Change Date;
- (iii) any additional matters which the Note Holder is required to disclose; and
- (iv) the title and telephone number of a person who will answer any question I may have regarding the notice.

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B. CHARGES; LIENS

Uniform Covenant 4 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

4. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, and other charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain a priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any, in the manner provided under paragraph 2 hereof or, if not paid in such manner, by Borrower making payment, when due, directly to the payee thereof. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts due under this paragraph, and in the event Borrower shall make payment directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing such payments. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument; however, Borrower shall not be required to discharge any such lien so long as Borrower:
(a) shall agree in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by such lien in a manner acceptable to Lender;
(b) shall in good faith contest such lien by, or defend against enforcement of such lien in, legal proceedings which in the opinion of Lender operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or forfeiture of the Property or any part thereof; or (c) shall secure from the holder of such lien an agreement in a form satisfactory to Lender subordinating such lien to this Security Instrument.

If Lender determines that all or any part of the Property is subject to a lien which may attain a priority over this Security Instrument, Lender shall give Borrower a notice identifying such lien. Borrower shall satisfy such lien or take one or more of the actions set forth above within ten days of the giving of the notice.

C. NOTICE

Uniform Covenant 14 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

14. Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail to Borrower at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower may designate by notice to Lender as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or to such other address as Lender may designate by notice to Borrower as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given in the manner designated herein.

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Uniform Covenant 15 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

D. UNIFORM SECURITY INSTRUMENT; GOVERNING LAW; SEVERABILITY

15. Uniform Security Instrument; Governing Law; Severability. This form of Security Instrument combines uniform covenants for national use and non-uniform covenants which limited variances by jurisdiction to combine a uniform security instrument covering real property. This Security Instrument shall be governed by Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision, and to this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

E. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER

17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property of an individual exercises such option to accelerate, Lender shall mail Borrower notice of acceleration in accordance with paragraph 14 hereof. Such notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is mailed within which Borrower may pay the sum declared due. If Borrower fails to pay such sums prior to the expiration of such period, Lender may, without further notice or demand on Borrower, invoke any remedies permitted by law unless Lender has released Borrower in writing.

Notwithstanding a sale or transfer, Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender has released Borrower in writing.

If Lender exercises such option to accelerate, Lender shall mail Borrower notice of acceleration by Lender if exercise is not authorized by Federal Law.

F. LOAN CHARGES

If the loan secured by the Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law permits only interest so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed permitted limits, then: (1) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (2) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceed limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment under this Note.

Borrower may, at Borrower's option, modify the repayment terms of the indebtedness secured by the Note during the first 5 years. At that time, Borrower may convert the Adjustable Rate Loan evidenced by the Note into a fixed interest rate loan to be fully repaid in equal monthly payments of principal and interest over the remaining term of the Note.
