

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tex neglects or refuses to yey the same after demand, the amount (including any interit, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whiether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Psirchaeer's, Holdess Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lighters, And Judgment Lies Creditors. — The Handillopesed by section \$21 shell not be valid as against any publisher, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment tien creditor until notices. thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Nitible; Form.—

(5) Place For Filing - The-hotice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed :

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(a) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of then is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be tracted as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period,

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of tien relited during the required reliting period shall be effective only (A) 11 -

(i) such notice of tien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a radiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such requisitions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a cartificate of release of any lien imposed with res any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Uconforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully suflefied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and ac a ted by him a boad that is conditioned upon the payme his amount expecsed, together with all interest in re thereof, within the time prescribed by law fincluding any extension of ruch time), and that is in accordance with much requirements "...ot" , to terms, conditions, and form of the lions and sureties thy son, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclasure of amount of outstanding ties. - If a notice of lien has been filed purewant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that the has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
