Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses is pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, legether with any costs that any accrus in addition thereto) shall be a lien in taxor of the United States upon all properly and rights to preparty, without raid or personal, belanging?

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security ins, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lion Creditors. - The ten imposed by section \$221 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liency, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof, which meets this requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

in Required Refilling Period. - in the or of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the asse ment of the two, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of Lien.

6325. Release Of Lien Or Sec. Discharge Of Property.

Of Lien. - Subject to se regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any iten (mposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or tinenforceable - The Bearstary finds that the liability for the amount accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully assisted or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary as eccepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment the amount assessed, together with all interest in raspe triproof within the time prescribed by lew (including as extension of such time), and that is in accordance with as require the time to terms, conditions, and form at the \$ and sureties the .on, as may be specified by such regulation

(k) Disciosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Discipsure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice at lion has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such ilen may be disclosed as any person who furnishes astrolectory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
