

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Corte

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

if any person Hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any inter est, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to properly, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the fien peed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so essessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Habitity) is satisfied or becomes unerforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inreets, Mischanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid at against any purchaser, holder of a security t, mechanic's lienar, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Flling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subiction (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(iii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is altuated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Beeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated.

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its ahysical ideation; or

(8) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp tyer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

Fir purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part erally shall be deemed to be the piace at which the principal continuotine of the business is located, and the residence (a 3 xr 2yet whose residence is without the United

States shall be formed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (1) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law recarding the form or content of a notice of lies.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required raffling period shall be affective only

(A) H -

(i) such notice of lien is taltied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of raftling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (I) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of tied under aubparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpeyer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of flen, the term "reculted refilling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the Jate of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period anding with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refitting period for such notice of Ilen.

Release Of Lien Or Sec. 6325. Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Roissse Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lian imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of th, a mount assessed, together with all interest in respect hand, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such require vents reinting to terms, conditions, and form of the bend and sureties there's, as may be specified by such regulations.
