

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cow

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the Ilen imposed by section 6:2f shall strips at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liab/lifty for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the Luxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6823. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Parchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The Hen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment Hen creditor units' notice thereof wigh meets the requirements of subsection (7) has been filed by the Secret Ley.

## (n Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of sersonal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the Iten is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lish is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of Subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Ileads Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the hen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Elen - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be attuated -

(A) fleat Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the page of personal property, minimiser tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpt yet at the time the notice of lien is fried.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partiers) p shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal ax cuts to affice of the business is fecated, and the residence of a fundamental without the United States shall be see ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(8) Form - The arm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice work to valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regards, the larm or content of a notice of lies.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though rotice of iten imposed by section 6321 is filled with respect to:

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section.
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of fights refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of film shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of iten reflied during the required refilling period shall be effective only (A) If -
  - (i) such notice of lien is ratifed in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
  - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
  - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of hotios of tien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the tax payer's residence. If a notice of such lien is also tilled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Fishing Period. — in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling pariod" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lieft. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of ruch time), and that is in accordance with such requirements in of ruch to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and substitutions are paying as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Seturns and Return information.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —
- (2) Discioure of amount of outstanding lien if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section \$323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who hyrhishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
