



REMARKS.—*Leptostoma* may have no additional characters, but  
it is distinguished from *Leptostomella* by the presence of a well-defined  
anterior lobe, which is wanting in the latter; and from *Leptostomella*  
by the presence of a distinct, well-defined, median lobe, which is  
wanting in *Leptostomella*. *Leptostoma* also has a more elongated body,  
and the ventral lobe runs in a straight line, without any irregularities,  
while the corresponding anastomosing ventral lobe of *Leptostomella*  
is characterized by a number of small, irregular, and somewhat  
irregularly placed, transverse folds.
