The South 251 feet of the East 263.87 feet of the South 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of Section 20, Township 42 North, range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, (Excepting therefrom that part thereof conveyed to the State of Illinois by Deed recorded January 28, 1970 as Document 21068116), in Cook County, Illinois.

That part of the South 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of Section 20, Township 4. North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Dounded and described as follows:

Beginning on the South line of the North 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of said Section at a point 263.87 feet West of the East line of the North East 1/4 of said Section; Thence running West 264.92 feet along the South line of the North 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of said Section; Thence North 330 feet parallel to the East line of the North East 1/4 of said Section; Thence Fast 264.92 feet parallel to the South line of the North 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of said Section; Thence South 330 feet parallel to the East line of the North East 1/4 of said Section; Thence South 330 feet parallel to the East line of the North East 1/4 of said Section, being the point of beginning, in Cook County, Illinois.
