THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS:

A (1) To pay said indebtedness and the interest thereon as herein and in said note provided, or according to any agreement extending the time of payment hereof. (2) To pay when due and before any penalty attaches thereto all taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water charges, and sewer service charges against said property (including those heretofore due) and to furnish Mortgagee, upon request, duplicate receipts therefor, and all such items extended against said property shall be conclusively deemed valid for the purpose of this requirement. (3) To keep the improvements now or hereafter upon said premises insured against damage by fire, and such other hazards as the Mortgagee may require to be insured against, and to provide public liability insurance and such other insurance as the Mortgagee may require, until said indebtedness is fully paid, or in case of foreclosure, until expiration of the period of redemption, for the full insurable value thereof, in such companies, through such agents or brokers, and in such form as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagee, such insurance policies shall remain with the Mortgagee during said period or periods, and contain the usual clause satisfactory to the Mortgagee making them payable to the Mortgagee, and in case of foreclosure sale payable to the owner of the certificate of sale, owner of any deficiency, any receiver or redemptioner, or any grantee in a deed pursuant to foreclosure, and in case of loss under such policies, the Mortgagee is authorized to adjust, collect and compromise, in its discretion, all claims therunder and to execute and deliver on behalf of the Mortgagor all necessary proofs of loss, receipts, vouchers, releases and acquittances required to be signed by the insurance companies, and the Mortgagor agrees to sign, upon demand, all receipts, vouchers, and releases required of him to be signed by the Mortgagee for such purpose, and the Mortgagee is authorized to apply the proceeds of any insurance claim to the restoration of the property or upon the indebtedness hereby secured in its discretion, but monthly payments shall continue until said indebtedness is paid in full; (4) immediately after destruction or damage, to commence and promptly complete the rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements now or hereafter on said premises, unless Mortgagee elects to apply on the indebtedness secured hereby the proceeds of any insurance covering such destruction or damage; (5) To keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from any mechanic's or other lien or claim of lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (6) Not to make, suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nuisance to exist on said property not to diminish nor impair its value by any act or omission to act; (7) To comply with all requirements of law with respect to mortgagee premises and the use hereof; (8) Not to make, suffer or permit without the written permission of the Mortgagee being first had and obtained, (a) any use of the property for any purpose other than that for which it is now used; (b) any alterations of the improvements, apparatus, appurtenances, fixtures or equipment now or hereafter upon said property; (c) any purchase on conditional sale, lease or agreement under which title is reserved in the vendor, of any apparatus, fixtures or equipment to be placed in or upon any buildings or improvements on said property.

B In order to provide for the payment of taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, and other annual charges upon the property securing this indebtedness, and other insurance required or accepted, I promise to pay to the Mortgagee, a prorata portion of the current year taxes upon the disbursement of the loan and to pay monthly to the Mortgagee, in addition to the above payments, a sum estimated to be equivalent to one-twelfth of such items, which payments may, at the option of the Mortgagee, (a) be held by it and commingled with other such funds or its own funds for the payment of such items; (b) be carried in a savings account and withdrawn by it to pay such items; or (c) be credited to the unpaid balance of said indebtedness as received, provided that the Mortgagee advances upon this obligation sums sufficient to pay said items as the same accrue and become payable. If the amount estimated to be sufficient to pay said items is not sufficient, I promise to pay the difference upon demand. If such sums are held or carried in a savings account, or escrow account, the same are hereby pledged to further secure this indebtedness. The Mortgagee is authorized to pay said items as charged or billed without further inquiry.

C This mortgage contract provides for additional advances which may be made at the option of the Mortgagee and secured by this mortgage, and it is agreed that in the event of such advances the amount thereof may be added to the mortgage debt and shall increase the unpaid balance of the note hereby secured by the amounts of such advance and shall be a part of said note indebtedness under all of the terms of said note and this contract as fully as if a new such note and contract were executed and delivered. An Additional Advance Agreement may be given and accepted for such advance and provision may be made for different monthly payments and a different interest rate and other express modifications of the contract, but in all other respects this contract shall remain in full force and effect as to said indebtedness, including all advances.

D That in case of failure to perform any of the covenants herein, Mortgagee may do on-Mortgagor's behalf everything so covenanted, that said Mortgagee may also do any act it may deem necessary to protect the lien hereof; that Mortgagor will repay upon demand any moneys paid or disbursed by Mortgagee for any of the above purposes and such moneys together with interest thereon at the highest rate for which it is then lawful to contract shall become so much additional indebtedness secured by this mortgage with the same priority as the original indebtedness and may be included in any decree foreclosing this mortgage and be paid out of the rents or proceeds of sale of said premises if not otherwise paid, that it shall not be obligatory upon the Mortgagee to check into the validity of any lien, encumbrance or claim in advancing moneys as above authorized, but nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagee to advance any moneys for any purpose nor to do any act hereunder, and the Mortgagee shall not incur any personal liability because of anything it may do or omit to do hereunder.

E That it is the intent hereof to secure payment of said note and obligation whether the entire amount shall have been advanced to the Mortgagor at the date hereof, or at a later date, and to secure any other amount or amounts that may be added to the mortgage indebtedness under the terms of this mortgage contract.

F That if all or any part of the property, or any interest therein, or if the mortgagor is a land trust, if all or any part of the beneficial interest in said trust is sold, transferred or assigned by the mortgagor without the prior consent of the mortgagee, excluding (a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this mortgage, (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances, (c) a transfer by devise, descent, or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Mortgagee, may, at Mortgagee's option, declare without notice all of the sums secured by this mortgage to be immediately due and payable.

Mortgagee shall have waived such option to accelerate if, prior to the sale or transfer, Mortgagee and the person to whom the property is sold or transferred reach agreement in writing that the credit of such person is satisfactory to Mortgagee and that the interest payable on the sum secured by this mortgage shall be at such rate as Mortgagee shall request. If Mortgagor's successor has executed a written disposition agreement accepted in writing by Mortgagee, Mortgagee shall release Mortgagor from all obligation under this mortgage and the note securing it.

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Subject to the terms of this paragraph, nothing in this mortgage contract shall prevent the Mortgagee from dealing with any successor in interest of the Mortgagor in the same manner as with the Mortgagor, and said dealings may include forbearing to sue or to wait for payment of the debt secured hereby, but said dealings shall not discharge or in any way affect the liability of the Mortgagor hereunder or the debt hereby secured.

G. That time is of the essence hereof and if default be made in performance of any covenant herein contained or in making any payment under said note or obligation or any extension or renewal thereof, or if proceedings be instituted to enforce any other lien or charge upon any of said property, or upon the filing of a proceeding in bankruptcy by or against the Mortgagor, or if the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of his creditors or if his property be placed under control of or in custody of any court, or if the Mortgagor abandon any of said property, or in the event of the filing of a suit to condemn all or a part of the said property, then and in any of said events, the Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagee hereunder, to declare without notice, all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, whether or not such default be remedied by Mortgagor, and apply toward the payment of said mortgage indebtedness any indebtedness of the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor, and said Mortgagee may also immediately proceed to foreclose this mortgage, and in any foreclosure a sale may be made of the premises en masse without offering the several parts separately.

H. That the Mortgagee may employ counsel for advice or other legal service at the Mortgagee's discretion in connection with any dispute as to the debt hereby secured or the lien of this instrument, or any litigation to which the Mortgagee may be made a party on account of this lien or which may affect the title to the property securing the indebtedness hereby secured or which may affect said debt or lien and any reasonable attorney's fees so incurred shall be added to and be a part of the debt hereby secured. Any costs and expenses reasonably incurred in the foreclosure of this mortgage and sale of the property securing the same and in connection with any other dispute or litigation affecting said debt or lien, including reasonably estimated amounts to conclude the transaction, shall be added to and be a part of the debt hereby secured. All such amounts shall be payable by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee on demand, and if not paid shall be included in any decree or judgment as a part of said mortgage debt and shall include interest at the highest contract rate, or if no such contract rate then at the legal rate. In the event of a foreclosure sale of said premises there shall first be paid out of the proceeds thereof all of the aforesaid amounts, then the entire indebtedness whether due and payable by the terms hereof or not and the interest due thereon up to the time of such sale, and the overplus, if any, shall be paid to the Mortgagor, and the purchaser shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

I. K. That upon the commencement of any foreclosure proceeding hereunder, the court in which such suit is filed may at any time, either before or after sale, and without notice to the Mortgagor, or any party claiming under him, and without regard to the solvency of the Mortgagor or the then value of said premises, or whether the same shall then be occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption as a homestead, appoint a receiver with power to manager and rent and to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and the statutory period of redemption, and such rents, issues and profits, when collected, may be applied before as well as after the sale, towards the payment of the indebtedness, costs, taxes, insurance or other items necessary for the protection and preservation of the property, including the expenses of such receivership, or on any deficiency decree whether there be a decree in personam or not, and if a receiver shall be appointed he shall remain in possession until the expiration of the full period allowed by statute for redemption, whether there be redemption or not, and until the issuance of deed in case of sale, but if no deed be issued, until the expiration of the statutory period during which it may be issued and no lease of said premises shall be nullified by the appointment or entry in possession of a receiver but he may elect to terminate any lease junior to the lien hereof.

L. That each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagee is cumulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagee, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith, that no waiver by the Mortgagee of performance of any covenant herein or in said obligation contained shall thereafter in any manner affect the right of Mortgagee to require or enforce performance of the same or any other of said covenants; that wherever the context hereof requires, the masculine gender, as used herein, shall include the feminine and the neuter and the singular number, as used herein, shall include the plural; that all rights and obligations under this mortgage shall extend to and be binding upon the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Mortgagor, and the successors and assigns of the Mortgagee; and that the powers herein mentioned may be exercised as often as occasion therefor arises.

M. That in the event the mortgagor is a duly organized corporation, the mortgagor does hereby waive all rights of redemption. In the event the mortgagor is a corporate trustee, and the improvements on said real estate contain four or more dwelling units, the mortgagor does hereby waive all rights of redemption.

The mortgagee is hereby subrogated to all rights, issues and profits of said lessors which are hereby assigned, transferred and set over unto the mortgagee whether now due or hereafter to become due as provided herein. The Mortgagee shall have the right to collect any amount due under this Agreement and to sue for the same in any court of competent jurisdiction.
