Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may acrose in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322./Period Of Lien.

Unless another date its epecifically fixed by law, the iten d Imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The Jen imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against shy purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor. O' Judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the Resements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

(n Place For Plling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental; subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property; whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to filen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien reflied during the required refiling period shall be affective only (A).II •

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of tien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliling is, entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a reliting of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such iten is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. - in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of ilen."

Release Of Lien Or 6325. Se¢. Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is jurnished to the Secretary and arc pled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereo, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of gigh time), and that is in accordance with such requirement, religing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure, of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding Hen. - If a notice of lien has been filed oursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property. 9301
