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# Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cove

### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs, that may accrue in addition thereta) shall be a lish flavor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether resil or personal, belonging to such person.

### Sec. 6322.: Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is appointed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment epainst the taxpayer arising but of such liability) as satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

## Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Credition. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's Hener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which mosts the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

# (n Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-

(A) Under Staff Laws

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flow is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is alfuated in the District of Columbia.

(Z) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated 
(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(b) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whicher tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tanger at the time the notice of lien is filled.

# (a) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this action -

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of tien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of ilen shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of iten refilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only

(A) If -

(i) such natics of ilen is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling, is, entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such iten is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reflling Pariod. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of tien.

# Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

# Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding fien. If a notice of fien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
