This Indenture, made this 1st day of March, 1971 between CENTRAL NATIONAL BANK IN CHICAGO, a corporation duly organized and existing as a national banking association under the laws of the United States of America, and duly authorized to accept and execute trusts within the State of Illinois, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said national banking association in pursuance of a certain Trust Agreement, dated the 31st day of March, 1964, and known as Trust Number 6171, party of the first part, and MARSHALL A. STUCKER, SARAH STUCKER, URSULA STUCKER AND DAVID L. STUCKER of COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, not as tenants in common, but as joint tenants, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$20,000.00 Dollars, and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid, does hereby grant, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part, not as tenants in common, but as joint tenants, the following described real estate, situated in COOK County Illinois, to-wit:

Parcel 1: That part of Block 42 in Canal Trustees' Subdivision of the West half of Section 27, Township 39 North, Range 14, East of the 3rd Principal Meridian, described as follows: - Commencing at the South East corner of said Block, thence West along the South line of said Block 150 feet; thence North 25 feet; thence East parallel with the South line of said Block to the West line of Cottage Grove Avenue; thence South Easterly along the West line of said Cottage Grove Avenue to the place of beginning (except that part dedicated for private alley); also 88116386

Parcel 2: Lots 1 and 2 in James Long and Others Subdivision of Block or out Lot 51 in Canal Trustees Subdivision above described, all in Cook County, Illinois, subject to restrictions as established by an instrument recorded as Document 12819044, party walls and party wall rights, if any, private alleys, zoning and building ordinances of record.

Parcel 3: That part of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 in Elijah Smith's Subdivision of Block 42 in the Canal Trustees' Subdivision of the West half of Section 27, Township 39 North, Range 14, East of 3rd Principal Meridian described as follows: - Beginning at the North East corner of said Lot 5 and running thence West along the North line thereof and of said Lot 2 (said North Line being also the South line of an alley) to a point 100 feet East of the West line of said Lot 2; thence due South to a point 9-1/2 feet South of South line of said Lot 2; thence Southeasterly on a line parallel with the West line of Lots 6 and 7 to a point 25 feet North of the South line of Lot 4 aforesaid; thence East on a line parallel with the North line of said Lots 2 and 5 to the West line of Cottage Grove Avenue; thence Northwesterly along the West line of Cottage Grove Avenue to the place of beginning (except that part of said premises included in private alley at the West end thereof).
