

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person flable to pay any tan neglects or retuses to say the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tail, or assessible ponelly, legation with any costs that may accrue in addition thresholds a lien in invest of the United States upon all property and lights to preparty, whether rate or personal, belonging to such parson.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unload another date is specifically fixed by law, its ilen impered by section 6221 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for this abount so sected (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by setting 822 shall not be valid as equinal the purchaser, helder of a security interest, recteated which meets the restrictments of subsection (i) has seen filed by the Secretary.

(i) Place For Filling Notice; Form.--

(ii) Parsonal Property - in the case of personal aroperty whether tangula or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, which the property subject to the limit is situated.

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which moets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Coods Of The District Of Columbia In the office of the Recorder of Goods of the District of Columbia of the property subject to the fight in situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Since Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, of its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, who her tangible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lies is filed.

For puriose t of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or park the small be deemed to be the place at which the principal at equiver office of the Business is located, and the residence of a training whose caldence is without the United States shall be decreed to the District of Joinmilla.

(3) Form - The races and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice stell is valid non-lithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of liae.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) **General Pule.** Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling paried, such notice of lien shall be tracial as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A natice of lien relited during the required refilling period shall be effective only a (A) if a
 - such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - this in the case of real property, the fact of retilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (6) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or hitre prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subperagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a pottee of such then is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the Steep in which such resedence is included.

(3) Required Railling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required cellling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which
- Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the flability for the amount essessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

- (in Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes, —
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. If a notice of lian has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the cutstanding obligation secured by such lian may be disclosed to any person who furnishes astisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
