

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#### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crue

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to trx, or assessable penalty, regetter with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto shall be a tion in fewer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

. Unless another rists is opecifically fixed by law, the floor imposed by section \$32) shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lease of time.

### Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shell not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgment lien creditor until netice thereof which mee's the registerments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### in Place For Filling Notice: Form.-

(3) Place For Filling . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental substyleton), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lish is situated; and

(in Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in whe office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the iten is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the orfice of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the Stato has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lian is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Susject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property chall be deemed to be situated (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

envelcal lecation; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, when ye tangible or intengible, at the meldence of the taxbever at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purplies, of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or permissive chalf be deemed to be the place at which the principal axicutive (MCs of the Cusiness is located, and the residence of a very cycl whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to to in the Nettict of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (at shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shift by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law requium, the form or content of a notice of lies.

- (g) Reilling Of Norice. For purposes of this section.
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien to reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date or which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reflifting period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) 17 -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is sitered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(6) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written Information (in the manner prescribed in regulations based by the Secretary) concerning a change in the tax payer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filled in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refling Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the term "required reflling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required radiing period for such notice of lies.

## Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Selease Of Lieft. Subject to such aguiations as the Secretary and issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tox not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished in the Secretary and neuroptal by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of unit lime), and that is in accordance with such requirements elsting to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surables those in an analyse specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

# (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding field. It is notice of fine has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
