## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crise

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refusee to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, angular with any corts that may accrue in addition theretol shall be a tian in fevor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether ruel or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lion.

Unless another sale is specifically fixed by law, the Ner Inspecied by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so accessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of qualitative) is sattlefied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lague of times.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, holders Of Security Inistration, Nechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The iten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## (7) Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The aptice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - in the ease of real property, in one office within the State (or the crassia, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject in the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tanglide to intanglide, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdiv.sion), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whitever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Ilen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject Yo Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be altusted -

cragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated.

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, wheth in tangible or intendible, at the residence of the taxosiyer at the time the notice of ilen is filled.

For pure less of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place 4 which the principal exclusive affice of the business is incosted, and the residence of a true pyer whose residence is without the United States shall be deeped to to in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice returned to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such netice shift b valid non-lithetanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling O1 Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rufe, Unless notice of then is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) **Place For Filling.** A notice of lion reflied during the required refliing period shall be effective only .

  (A) if
  - (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
  - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
  - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of Hen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Acquired Reliting Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tex, and (B) the one-year (reflored ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the prechoing required refliing period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) **Release** Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shelf issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on whigh.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforcable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the simpunt accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become leadily unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assassed together with all interest in majoritherant, within the time prescribed by law (not unlike auch acceptance).

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(ii) Disclosure of Cartain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding flen - If a notice of flen has been filled pursuant to section (323(f)), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such flen may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such flen or intents to obtain a right in such property.
