

Sec. 8321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any fire neglects or refuses to jusy the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable pensity, septies with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a line flavor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such passen.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

() Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(f) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be field -

(A) Under Statu Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal graperty, whother tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to filen is situated, wherever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds (i) The District of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of caragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be desired to be situated. (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, et its.

(3) Form - The firm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regatomy the form or content of a notice of lifet.

ig) Reffling Of Notice, — For purposes of this section -

- (i) **General Rule.** Unless notice of filen is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lian shall be treated as filed on the date province it list fried (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such refiting period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -
 - such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner preactibed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpeyor's residence. If a natice of such tien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refling Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the term "regulard refilling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the praceding required refilling period for such notice of lies.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is turnished to the Secretary and access did by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the impount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of soundime), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies there are as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the cutstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or interests to obtain a right in such property.
