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

Excerpts From Internal Revenus Cour

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person flable to pay any tax neglects or refuses for ipay the same after demand, the amount (including any intertest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty ingether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property; whether real or personal, belonging: to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapsopt time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

in Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests. Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Graditors. — The flen imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interport mechanic's lienor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (7) has been filed by the Secretary.

in Place For Filing Notice; Form. --

(1) Place For Filing - The notice relevant to in subsection (a) shall be tiled .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental 'subdivision), ná designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(iii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the Blate (or the county, or other governments) aubdivision), as designated by the taws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court . In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder DI Deeds DI The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia:

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(2) Bitus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs [1] and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, mitter tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxps yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or part, ers' in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal ar cult re-ffice of the business is facated, and the residence of Diay layer whose residence is without the United States shall be use ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The corm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice on a un valid notwithstanding any Other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien.

- (a) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of fien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of then refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only.

 - orior notice of tian was filed, and (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (d), and
 - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a raffling of notice of lien under autograph (A), the

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Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such fien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the Blate in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Reflling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling partod" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the sesessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien, Subject to such repulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (i) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully autisticd or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and ac a ted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of amount assessed, logether with all interest in respect thereof, with: the time prescribed by lew (including any extension of such time), and that is in apportance with such requirements stating to terms, conditions, and form of the field and sureties the son, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure or heturns and Return Information.

- (a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If a notice of Hen has been filled pursuant to section \$323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such Jian may be disclosed to any person who lumishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to oblain a right in such property.
