

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cuda

Sec. 6321. Llen For Taxes.

if any person itable to pay any tax neglects or refuses: to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interast, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, logather with any costs that may accrue in addition theratol shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ilen-Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lansa of time.

Sec. 6323, Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanic's <u>Hennt</u>, or judgment iten creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been flied by the Secretary.

m Place For Fling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deede of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is altuated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs-Of-Property Subject To Lien: - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the

taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purchase of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par, nar, allow shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal a reculy affice of the business is located; and the residence of a furniyer whose residence is without the United States shall be dramad to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to in subscrition (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice rhall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law required the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (p) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reflling period, such notice of ilen shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) 11 -

(I) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the pilor notice of ilen was filed, and

(ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(8) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a raffiling of notice of flen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence. If a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period, — In the case of any notice of lian, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tex, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

6325. Sec. Release Of Lien Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally phenforcuable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Becretary and and opted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect therer, will in the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements religing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties therein, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Heturns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
