FINDING & JUDGMENT

Defendant has been convicted as charged of the offense(s) of knowingly, willfully and unlawfully, did distribute controlled substance; did furnish false and fraudulent information in reports.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 843(a)(4)(A). 88134270

SENTENCE OR PROBATION ORDER

The court asked whether defendant had anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced. Because no sufficient cause to the contrary was shown, or appeared to the court, the court adjudged the defendant guilty as charged and convicted and ordered that

IT IS ADJUDGED that on each of counts 1 and 2 the imposition of sentence is hereby suspended and the defendant is placed on probation for a period of FIVE (5) YEARS on condition that he comply with the general conditions of probation. As a further condition of probation defendant shall reside in and participate in the work release program of the Metropolitan Correctional Center for a period of 60 Days. It is further ordered that the defendant pay a fine to the United States in the sum of \$2,500.00.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

Said sentence on counts 1 and 2 to run concurrently with each other.

The defendant Arvin Finkelman is hereby ordered to surrender himself by reporting to the Metropolitan Correctional Center on October 13, 1987.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

It is the further order of this Court pursuant to 18 U.S.C. section 3013(a) that the defendant is assessed the sum of \$50.00 on each of counts 1 and 2 for a total assessment of \$100.00.

In addition to the special conditions of probation imposed above it is hereby ordered that the general conditions of probation set out on the reverse side of this judgment be imposed. The Court may change the conditions of probation, reduce or extend the period of probation, and at any time during the probation period or within a maximum probation period of five years permitted by law, may issue a warrant and revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period.

COMMITMENT RECOMMENDATION

The court orders commitment to the custody of the Attorney General and recommends
