MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED 14-01-1988, BETWEEN John F. Richard and Fred Richard, ("GRANTOR"), whose address 11839. Let Palos Heights,, Illinois 60463; and Interstate Bank of Oak Forest ("LENDER"), whose address is 15533 South Cicero Avenue, Attn: Loan Department, Oak Forest, Illinois 60452.

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For value* ic consideration, Grantor mortgages and warrants and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures, all easements, royalties, appurtenances, all rights rolating to the real property (including minerals, oil, gas, water, and the like), and all ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights) is content in Cook County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property") and legally described as:

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means without limitation all existing and future buildings, structures, facilities, additions and similar construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under he Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage.

Lender. The word "Lander" means Interstate Bank of Oak Forest. The Lander is the mortgagee under this Wirtgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the real property described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include any promissory notes, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, and all other documents executed in connection with this Mortgage or the Indebtedness, whether now or hereafter existing.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, and profits from the Reat Property and the Personal Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THE NOTE AND THIS MORTGAGE AND IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that its possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

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Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and never will be so long as this Mortgage remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), applicable state laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to either of the foregoing. Grantor agrees to Indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this provision of the Mortgage. This obligation to indemnify shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and satisfaction of this Mortgage.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof, including without limitation removal, or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or soil, or gravel or rock products.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title or interest therein; who ther logal or equitable; whother voluntary or involuntary; by outright sale; dood; installment sale contract; land contract; contract for deed; leasehold interest wiln it term greater than three years; lease-option contract; sale, assignment or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Ruci P enerty; or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. It any Grantor is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due belore they become delinquent all taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims to work done on or for services rendered or material turnished to the Property. Granter shall maintain the Property free of all fiens having priority eye, c. equal to the interest of Lender under this Mongage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filled as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filled, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure up discharge of the lien or deposit with Lender, cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the flen plus any costs, attorneys' tees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender evidence of payment of the taxes or assessment, and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lendor at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanics, materialmens, or other construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$1,000.00. Granter will on request furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Granter can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

Tax and insurance Reserves. Grantor shall establish a tax and insurance reserve account to be retained from the loan proceeds in such amount does do be sufficient by Londor and shall pay monthly into that reserve account an amount equivalent to 1/12th of the annual real estate taxes and insurance premiums, as estimated by Londer, so as to provide sufficient funds for the payment of each year's taxes and insurance premiums one month prior to the date taxes and premiums become delinquent. If the amount so estimated and paid shall prove to be insufficient to pay such taxes, Insurance premiums, assessments and other charges, Grantor shall pay the difference on demand. Lender shall have the right to draw upon the reserve (or pledge) account to pay such item; and Lender shall not be required to determine the validity or accuracy of any item before paying it. Nothing herein shall be construed as requiring Lender to advance other monies for such purposes and Lender shall not incur any liability for anything it may do or omit to do hereunder. All amounts 🗭 in any tax and insurance account are hereby pledged to further secure the Indebtedness; and Lender is hereby authorized to withdraw and apply such account on the Indobtedness in the event of default.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of line insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colnsurance clause, and with a standard mortgageo clause in favor of Lender. In no event shall the insurance be in an amount less than \$160,000.00. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Granter shall deliver to Londer certificates of

coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Granter shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Granter fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien allecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Granter shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Granter from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Granter is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to pay any amounts owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to propay accused interest, and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Granter.

Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would affect Lender's Interests in the Property, Lender may, at its option, on Grantor's behalf take the required action and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the date of expenditure until paid at the Note rate. The rights provided in his section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. By taking the required action, Lender shall not cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF (1715.

Title. Grantor warrants that it makes marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in any policy of title incurance issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lander in connection with this Mortgage.

Defense of Title. Subject to the executor in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any extrem or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Morgage, Grantor shall defend the action at its expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from ting to the operation participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that its use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Londer may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, or Londer is connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filled, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor mry be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by crumal of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAX BY STATE.

State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this socilor applier: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on any Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by any Grantor.

Remedies. If any state tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as a default, and Lender may exercise any or all of the remedies available to it in the event of a detail unless the following conditions are met: (a) Grantor may lawfully pay the tax or charge imposed by the state tax; and (b) Grantor pays or offers to pay the tax or charge within 30 days after notice from Lender that the tax law has been enacted.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue the security interest granted in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Lender within three days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing address of Grantor (debtor) and the mailing address of Lender (secured party) from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code) are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage and the Note, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. The following shall constitute events of default:

Default on Indebtedness. Borrower fails to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent filling of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Rolated Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding 12 months, it may be cured (and no event of default will have occurred) if Grantor, after receiving written notice from Londer demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within 15 days; or (b) if the cure requires more than 15 days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Steaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, talse in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commoncement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency taws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or tllinois taw, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an event of default under this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any craditor of Grantor against any of the Property, however this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the busis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and turnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Leasehold Default. If the are less of Grantor in the Property is a leasehold interest, any default by Grantor under the terms of the lease, or any other event (whether or not the fault of Grantor) that results in the termination of Grantor's leasehold rights.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any brainsh by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guarantors. Any of the precading events occur with respect to any guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or such guarantor dies or becomes incompetent, unless the obligation to it is guaranty and related agreements have been unconditionally assumed by the guarantor's estate in a manner satisfactory to Lendor.

Insecurity. If Lender reasonably dooms itself insecure

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrer ce of any event of default and at any time thereafter, Lender may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other right cor remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its opic n without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Londer shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take pussession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, defined the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use to sufficiently to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor Irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession of to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, I gainst the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Londer's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Londer shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreglosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Granter's Interest in all or any part of the Property.

Nonjudicial Sate. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may foreclose Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Personal Property by nonjudicial sale.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies, Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or by law.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor heroby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to self-all or any part of the Property together or suparately, in one sale or by suparate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least 10 days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to dectare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses

covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorney fees and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining little reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law.
