

This Indenture,

Made January 14, 1988, between Western National Bank of Cicero, a National Banking Association, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a Deed or Deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said Bank in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated July 19, 1984 and known as Trust No. #9213 herein referred to as "First Party," and DAVID M. 
