

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cut)

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any lax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interst, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

- Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.
  - Unless enether date is specifically fixed by law, the fien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so ed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of euch liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lance of time.
- Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.
- (a) Purchaser's, Holders O! Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lion Creditors. — The Hen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanic's Denot, or Judgment Hen creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Sebratary.

## (1) Place For-Piling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Fling - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed ->

(A) Under State Later
(i) Real Property in the case of real property, in one office within the State to the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has most by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. when her tangible or imangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purriose, of paragraph (Z) (B), the residence of a corporation or parhamatic shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal as scutter office of the business is located, and the residence of a trailing reviewe residence is without the United States shall be decimed to 50 in the District of Columbia.

(8) Form - The form and centent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- Securities
- Motor vehicles
- Personal property purchased at retail
- Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory lien Real property tex and special assessment liens
- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements
- Attorney's ilens
- Cartain insurance contracts
- Pasabook loans
- (a) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paregraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date orrwhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -(A) II -
  - (i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
  - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
  - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiting of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is lucated.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required radling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reftling period for auch notice of lien.

## Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. 6325. Sec.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has hecome legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and arc, we led by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of curly lime), and that is in accordance with such requirements falsting to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suraties the ore, as may be specified by such regulations.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such field or intends to obtain a right in such property
