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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or harcafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for then not expressly subordinated to the tien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a fien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgages; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of taw or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material attentions in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.

The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order () pricity: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding raingraph hereof; second, all other litems which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with indirect thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 12. Upon or at any time after the filling of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of sale premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solventy of insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the filen value of the premises or whether the time shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect therents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. - 13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and evallable to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
 - 14. The Mortgages shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose,
- 15. The Mortgagors shall periodically deposit with the Mortgagee such sums as the Mortgagee may reasonably require for payment of taxes and assessments on the premises. No such deposit shall bear any interest.

If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or veried or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgages, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.
