Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pry the same after demand, the amount (including any interest) additional amount, addition to tax or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United Stales upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

of lapse of line Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purcosars, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic an Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors.— Indition imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against siny purchaser, holder of a security interest. mechanic's liegar; or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (1) has been filed by the Secretary

- (1) Place For Filing Notice: Form.--
- (1) Place For Filling.—The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-
 - (A) Under State Laws --
 - (i) Real Property In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and
 - (ii) Personal Property In the case of personal proper ty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated. Or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in the property subject to the lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section-
- (1) Conoral Rule.—Unless notice of hen is relifed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of hen shall be freated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with
- subsection (I)) after the expiration of such refiling period
 (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lien refiled during the required retiting period shall be effective only-
- (i) such notice of tien is refuled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Robuse Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue taix not tater than 30 days after the day wit
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Uncolorccable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable, or
- (2) Bond Accepted -- There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all i levest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law a.any extension of such time), and that is in accormits such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and firm of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations
