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POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, BERNARD A. HICKEY, husband of Marylee A. Hickey of Park Forest, IL, do hereby make, constitute and appoint my daughter, MAUREEN MCHUGH of Des Plaines, IL, my true and lawful Attorney in Fact, for me and in my name, place an stead:

1. To make, execute and file any and all tax returns upon personal or real estate, income, or any other tax that may be levied or imposed by any lawful authority, and to settle, compromise or pay the same or to collect any and all refunds or repayments thereof.

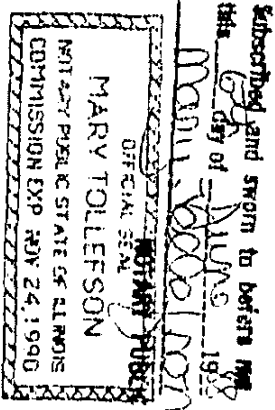
2. To sign, endorse, execute, deliver, and renew any and all checks, promissory notes, bonds, bills of exchange, trade acceptances, or other evidences of indebtedness, and to waive notice of demand and protest thereon, and upon any and all promissory notes, bonds, checks, drafts, or other instruments in writing which I have heretofore executed or endorsed; to deposit or withdraw any money or credits and/or otherwise to transact any and all business with any bank or trust company, or any savings and loan association, or any depository or financial institution of any kind in the State of Illinois, or elsewhere.

Any such bank or trust company, or any savings and loan association, or any depository or financial institution of any kind, is hereby authorized and empowered to pay any checks, drafts, notes, bills of exchange, trade acceptances and other commercial paper signed, accepted or endorsed by my said attorney, and to receive the same for the credit of or in payment from the payee or any holder thereof, without inquiry or the application or disposition of the proceeds thereof, whether the same are made payable to my said attorney's individual obligations, or otherwise.

3. To borrow money, in such amount or amounts as my said attorney shall deem best, and to sign, endorse, accept, execute and deliver promissory notes, bonds, and any other form or forms of obligation necessary or convenient to evidence said indebtedness, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, hypothecation, assignment, endorsement, or otherwise, of any property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, and to make, instruments or contracts thereof; to make substitutions of any securities; to renew or obtain extensions of time on any loan or loans for such period or periods of time and upon such security and terms as my said attorney shall deem best; to endorse, assign, pledge and hypothecate any and all personal property, stocks, bonds, and other securities, policies of life insurance, and other instruments in writing as security for any such loan or loans, with power to sell, assign, transfer, convey and endorse for transfer any stocks, bonds or other evidences of title to any property whatsoever owned by me, and to make such sale, transfer, assignment, or conveyance for such prices and upon such terms conditions as my said attorney shall deem wise.

4. To pay any and all debts so incurred by said attorney and any and all other proper debts owing by me, irrespective of whether or not the same be evidenced by a note, draft, or other written instrument.

6. To demand, institute legal proceedings for, recover, collect and receive any and all manner of goods, chattels, debts, claims, demands, choses in action, duties, rents, sum and sums of money whatsoever, due or hereafter to become due and owing, or belonging to me or on any account whatsoever, by any person or persons whomsoever, and upon receipt of the same, or any part or parts thereof, to make execute and deliver all proper receipts, releases or other discharges of and for the same, under seal or otherwise.

7. To compound, compromise, settle and adjust all claims and demands whatsoever, due or hereafter to become due or owing or belonging to me, or which I may now or hereafter owe or be liable for, and to execute and deliver, or to receive all proper receipts and releases or discharges therefor.

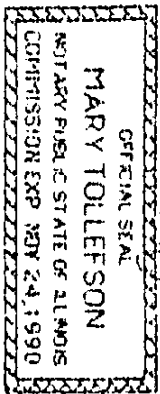
8. To grant extensions of time for the payment of any debts, claims or demands, due or hereafter to become due or owing to me, for such periods and on such terms as my said attorney shall deem best, with or without security.

9. To lease, rent, release, manage, deal with, contract to sell and sell and convey in fee simple or lesser estate by deed or any instrument, and the same to deliver with or without covenants of warranty for such price and upon such terms of credit, and with such other provisions, and to such person or persons as my Attorney in fact shall deem proper, the whole or any part of or any interest in any lands, tenements, hereditaments or any personal property, tangible or intangible, of any kind whatsoever and wheresoever situated; and to preserve, repair or improve any such interest or property as he shall deem proper.

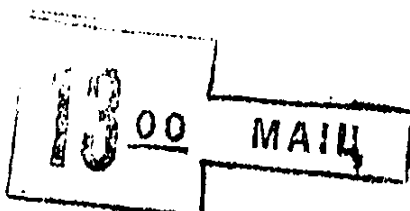
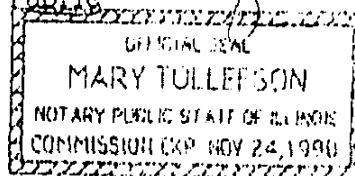
