And said JULIE ANN PLOURDE does hereby irrevocably constitute and appoint CHARLES KAPLAN as her true and lawful attorney for and in her place and stead, in her name and on her behalf to make, execute and deliver deeds and other instruments conveying, assigning, giving or otherwise transferring any and all right, title and interest which she now has or may hereafter acquire as wife of said CHARLES KAPLAN under any present or future law of the State of Illinois or of any other state of the United States of American or of any foreign country in and to any and all property and estate, legal or equitable, real, personal or mixed, of said CHARLES KAPLAN now owned or hereafter at any time acquired by him, and wheresoever situated; and said JULIE ANN PLOURDE does hereby acknowledge that the power of attorney herein granted is given for a valuable consideration and is coupled with an interest and is absolutely irrevocable.

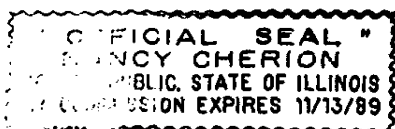
