

(Z) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of parsonal property, ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxp: yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or part eral ip shall be deemed to be the piece at which the principal ar cutive office of the business is foosted, and the residence of the layer whose residence is without the United States shall be ver ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The orm and content of the notice referred to in subsection (u) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice and a valid notwithstanding any other provision of law registric the form or content of a notice of tien.

- (g) Reffling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unices notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reflling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date prowhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reflling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of iten reflied during the required refilling period shall be effective only -(A) If -
 - (i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
- (8) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a ratifing of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such item to also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the Biate in which such residence is located.

(2) Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refilling period" means. (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such netice of lien.

6325. Release Of Lien Or Sec. Discharge Of Property.

- Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal rayenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- 12) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of he amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, and the time prescribed by law (including any extensi in of a ich time), and that is in accordance with such requirement in turn to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties herein. as may be specified by such regulations.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cours

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interadditional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may active in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether read or personal, belonging to such carson.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the ilen imposed by section 6221 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so sessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of schillely) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by resson

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security innic's Lienors, And Judgment forests, Mostanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditate, — The ten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as a least any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanical lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Sicratary.

th Place for Fling Notice: Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subcison (e) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, In which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is ultuated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of auboerzorzok (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Di Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lice is situated in the District of
