



AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN PUBLIC ALLEY IN THE VILLAGE OF DOLTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Dolton, Illinois, after due investigation and consideration, and upon recommendation of the Plan Commission of said Village, have determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of a certain public alley hereinafter described and shown on the Plat of Vacation attached hereto, and made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated, inasmuch as the same is not required for public use and the business interest will be subserved by such vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolton, Cook County, Illinois, being a home-rule unit of government, as follows:

SECTION I. That:

ALL OF THE HERETOFORE DEDICATED 16.00 FOOT VIDE EAST-WEST ALLEY IN BLOCK 2 IN CALIMET PARK, A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 3 IN COUNTY CLERK'S LIVISION OF UNSUBDIVIDED LANDS IN THE EAST 1/2 OF SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 14 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN LOCK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,

according to the Plat of Vacation prepared by Joseph S. Studnick & Associates, dated May 18, 1988, be and is hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That the owner of the adjacent property agrees to pay all engineering and legal fees as well as recording costs incurred by virture of this vacation.

SECTION III. The Clerk of the Village of Dolton be and is hereby

authorized and directed to file a true and correct copy of this ordinance and Plat of Vacation attached hereto in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
