

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cray

Sec 8321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition therets) shall be a lien in fever of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging be such person

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lies reposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the same is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so ed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lieft Creditors. - The Hen imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder at a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subnection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Linder State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governments) subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to fien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which mosts the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Doods of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the ken is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Cleat - For purposes of

paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be desired to be attuated (A) Rust Property - In the case of real property, at its attysical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, orner tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxsaver at the time the notice of lien is filed

(3) Form . The form and content at the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice pty A by valid notwithstanding any ether provision of law regative the form or content of a notice of lies.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this saction
- (1) General Rule, Unless natice at lien is retiled in the manner prescribed in peragraph (2) during the required refiting period, such notice of her shall be treased as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such raffling parted.
- @ Place For Filing. A notice of lien reflied during the required refiting period shall be effective only iÁi II -
 - (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the arror notice of tien was fried, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (1) (4), and
 - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date at a refling of notice of lies under aubparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the main prescribed in requisitions issued by the Sacreti concurring a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a ne of such lies is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is second.

(3) Required Retting Period. -- in the at of any notice of lies, the term "required refilling period" m (A) the one-year period sending 30 days after the suprestion of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the talk, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required reffling period for such notice of ties.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shi leave a certificate of release of any ben imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unerforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount absenced, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully senialled or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and act sp'ad by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payme b. amount passesed, together with all interest in ress thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extensit a of a ch time), and that is in eccordance with such requirements triadry to terms, conditions, and form of the flend and sureties they an as may be specified by such requisitions.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(x) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes. --

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding ilen. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section \$323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
