

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Co/A

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to say the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereit together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereit together with any costs of the United States upon all property and rights to preperty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the illen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the illability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of section in the interest in the satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of inces of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Fusichaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, flechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Cribditors. — The iten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, meetanic's itenor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed to be Secretary.

m Place For Filling Notice: Form.--

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated:

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of enhancements of A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - in the office of the Recorder of Beeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the Nen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(Z) Situs (11 Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated - (A) Real Property - in the case of real preparty, at its convolcal legation; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whenever tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpe; or at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purpose of peragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partin rath) shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive effice of the business is located, and the residence of a tear whose residence is without the United States shall be down at to be an the District of Columbia.

States shall be deer ad to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and centent of the notice referred to in estageous (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice sne't be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding to form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

(f) General Rule. — Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated at filed on the date prowhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reffling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of lien refiled during the required refling benod shall fail attacking only.

(A) II -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such iten is also tilled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means-(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years efter the close of the preceding required refiling period for

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lifen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

 Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has secome legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and acc and by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the mount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of a th time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surrelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

To (k)-Discipeure of Certain Returns and Return, information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f) the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
