

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cut's

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to sey the same after demand, the amount (including any interset, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, segather with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6521 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unempressible by reason of lease of time.

Sec. 6329. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purphaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Michanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid-of against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, meditasic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Mace For Fiting - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(1) Resi Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governments) auditivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is attuated;

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of authorizarianh (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be estuated (A) Real Property - In the case of real graperty, at its physical lucation; or

(M) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, who her tampible or intempible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the netice of hen is filed.

For purpose 1 of paragraph (2) (II), the residence of a corporation or personally, whelf be deemed to be the place at which the principal is earlier effice of the business is located, and the residence of a Purpoyar whose residence is without the United States shall be de med in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and centent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice of all is valid notwithstanding any other provision of law require, the form or content of a notice of law.

- (g) Refising Of Notice. For purposes of this section.
- (1) **General Rule.** Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during this required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated at Tilet on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Piece For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall dediffective only (A) if -
 - (i) such notice of lien is raffled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
 - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a rafiling of nation of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the marrier prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a charge in the taxopyer's residence, if a notice of such tien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the class of the procedure required refiling period for such action of item.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lieft. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (3) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has hecome lenally unenforceable, or
- t2) Bend Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and policy sed by him a bend that is conditioned upon the payment of the smorth assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof with the time prescribed by law (Including any extension of acceptance with such requirements, see log to terms, conditions, and form of the bend and suraties thereof, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

no po-Disclosure: of Certain Returns and Return, information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien - If a notice of filen has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
