THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS LEARNED TO ON HAGE THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgages; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of Illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagors, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagors, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagors to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagors, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.
- 4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the note hereby secured, the Mortgagors covenant and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagors further covenant to hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.
- 5. At such time a, the Mortgagors are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagors shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.
- 6. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstrom under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payabi, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and so I deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 7. In case of default therein, Martiagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed experient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said pre nists or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in commercial including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest fact on at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accreting to the Mortgagee on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 8. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby jult orized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or it's or claim thereof.
- 9. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, occur educ and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
- 10. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due when's by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness add ito all to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the rote; ourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 12. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which sich complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. - 13. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
- 14. The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that burpose.

Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be furnished a conformed copy of the Note and of this Mortgage at the time of execution or within a reasonable time after recordation hereof.

Acceleration: Remedies. Upon Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement of Borrower in this Mortgage, including the covenants to pay when due any sums secured by this Mortgage, Lender, prior to accelerating the sums secured by this Mortgage, shall mail notice to Borrower by certified mail, addressed to the address of the Mortgaged Property or to such other address as Borrower may have designated in writing to Lender, specifying: (1) the breach; (2) the action required to cure such breach; (3) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is mailed to Borrover, by which such breach must be cured; and (4) that failure to cure such breach on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and sale of the Mortgaged Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to bring a court action to aggert the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and sale. If the breach is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice; Lender, at Lender's option may declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable without further demand and may invoke the power of sale hereby granted and any other remedies permitted by applicable law. Lender shall be entitled to collect all reasonable costs and expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this paragraph, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees.

If Lender invokes the power of sale, Lender shall cause a copy of a notice of sale to be served upon the person, if any, in possession of the Mortgaged Property. Lender shall publish a notice of sale and the Mortgaged Property snall be sold at public auction in the manner prescribed by applicable law. Lender or Lender's designee may purchase the Mortgaged Property at any sale. The proceeds of this sale shall be applied in the following order: (a) to all sums secured by this Mortgage; (b) to all reasonable costs and expenses of the sale, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and costs of title evidence; and (c) the excess, if any, to the person or persons legally entitled thereto.
