GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For vrius lie consideration, Grantor mortgages, and warrants and conveys to Lender, at it! Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and into an in and to the Rents from the Real Property. In addition, Grantor grants Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property described below.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Morigage.

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means ANDREW D. ROSS and RENAE S. POSS. The words "Borrower" and "Grantor" are used interchangeably in this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means ANDREW D. ROSS and RENAE S. ROSS "Init" words "Grantor" and "Borrower" are used interchangeably at this Mortgage. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means without limitation all existing and future buildings, structures, facilities, additions and similar construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the living and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage.

Lender. The word "Lender" means Heritage Olympia Bank. The Lender is the mortgagee under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation as assignments and security interest of provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means that certain note or credit agreement dated 07-29-1988 in the original principal amount of \$126,400.00 from Borrower to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of and substitutions for the note or extrement. The interest rate on the Note is 10.000%. The currently scheduled final payment of principal and interest on the Note will be due on or before 08-01-1933.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, findures, and other articles of personal property owned by Grantor, now or subsequently attached or affixed to the Real Property, together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions of for any of such property, and together with all proceeds (including insurance proceeds and relainds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of such property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the real property described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include any promissory notes, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, and all other documents executed in connection with this Mortgage or the Indebtedness, whether now or hereafter existing

Rents. The word "Rents" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, and profits from the Real Property and the Personal Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNCER THE NOTE AND THIS MORTGAGE AND IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that its possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in detault, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and never will be so long as this Morigage remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), applicable state lews, or regulations adopted pursuant to either of the foregoing. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this provision of the Mortgage. This obligation to indemnify shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and satisfaction of this Mortgage.

Hulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof, including without firmitation removal, or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or soil, or gravel or rock products.

Resoval of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. Lender's Right to Enter. (ander and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property.

Compliance with Governmental (sequirements). Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or surety bond (reasonably satisfactory to Lender) to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor shall do all other acts, in Addition to those acts self-forth above in this section, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

Lender may align ontion, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Wortgage upon the sale or transfer of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest therein, without the Lender's prior written consent. A "sale or transfer means the conveyance of real property or any right, after or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary by involuntary by outright sale ideed, installment sale contract; land contract; contract for deed; leasehold interest with a ferm greater than three years, lease-option contract, sale, assignment or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property; or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 2.5% of the voting stock of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxos, y could take assessments, water charges and server service that ges teved against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for york done on or for services rendered to matternal furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all tens having priority or or for equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the fein of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the Vollowing paragraph.

Right To Contest. Granter may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in confection with a good fath dispute over the obligation to pay so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lander at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services in a funnheid or any manuals are supplied to the Property, if any mechanics, materialments, or other construction lies tould be asserted on account of the kiloric services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$5,000.00. Grantor will on request furnish to Lander advance assurances satisfactory to Lander kiloric can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full visurable value covering all Improvements on the Rear Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any consurance clause of and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. In no event shall the insurance be in an amount less than \$126.400.00. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to tiender confidences of coverage from each insuran containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days prior aritism notice at the Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor talls to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any less affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimbursa Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to pay any amounts owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

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Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any forectosure sale of such Property

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would affect Lander's interests in the Property. Lender may, at its option, on Grantor's behalf take the required action and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the date of expenditure until paid at the Note rate. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. By taking the required action, Lender shall not cure the default so as to ber it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE.

Title. Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all fiens and encumbrances other than those set forth in any policy of title insurance issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lander in connection with this Mortgage.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at its expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lander such instruments as may be propested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Gantor warrants that its use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION.

Application of Net Proceeds. If at or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebted loss. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' less necessarily paid or inclured by Grantor, or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceedings in conditionation are field, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps. as may be necessary to defend the action and rouin the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represeded in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAX BY STATE.

State Taxes Covered. Grantor her by appoints Lender as Grantor's aborney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue the security interest granted in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mongage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authors around from Granton, file copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perletting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Lender within three days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. FULL PERFORMANCE. DEFAULT. The following shall constitute events of default:

Default on Indebtedness. Borrower fails to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent fling of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding 12 months, it may be cured (and no event of default will have occurred) if Grantor, after receiving written index demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within 15 days; or (b) if the cure requires more than 15 days; immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's properly, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the confirmancement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Illinois law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an event of default under this Mortgage.

Insecurity. If Lander rear unitary deems itself insecure.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON LEGALT. Upon the occurrence of any event of default and at any time thereafter. Lender may emercise any one or more of the following rights and remedial in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender with have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or arm part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the **Hinois Uniform Commercial Code.**

Collect Rents. Lander shall have the right, warruit notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents. Including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, ow/ and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor mevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attornity in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by famints or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper gradual for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mirtgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and presents the Property.
