Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any lax neglects or refuses to pa the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, logether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is enecifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer ansing out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapes of tens

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which
