WHEREAS, the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, including the principal thereof and interest and premium, if any, thereon, and any extensions and renewals thereof, in whole or in part, and any and all other sums which may be at any time due or owing or required to be paid as herein or in Note provided, are herein called the "Indebtedness Hereby Sezured."

NOW. THEREFORE, THIS MORTGAGE WITNESSETH:

That to secure the payment of the principal of and interest and premium, if any, on the Note according to its tenor and effect and to secure the payment of all other Indebtedness Hereby Secured and the performance and observance of all the covenants, provisions and agreements herein and in the Note contained (whether or not the Mortgagor is personally liable for such payment, performance and observance) and in consideration of the premises and Ten Dollars (\$10) in hand paid by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor, and for other good and valuable

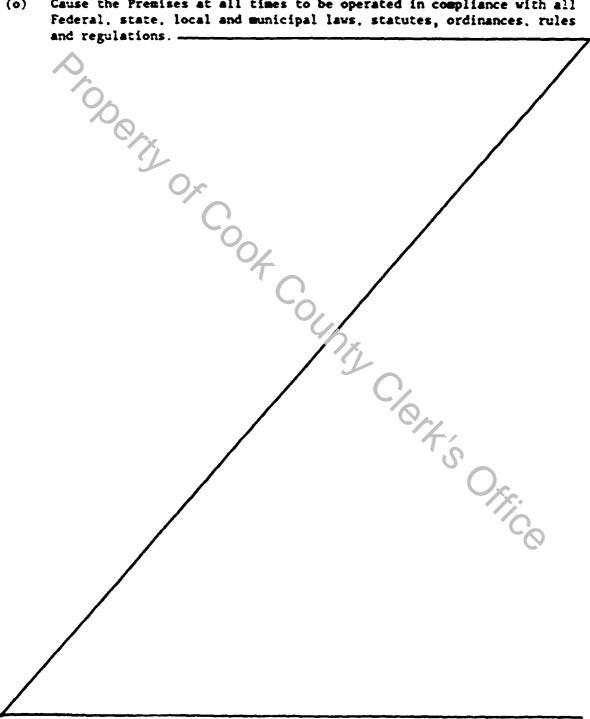

- 4. Insurance Coverage. Fire Mortgagor will insure and keep insured the Premises and each and every part and parcel thereof against such pirils and hazards as the Mortgagee may from time to time require, and in any event including:
 - (a) Insurance against loss to the Improvements caused by fire, lightning and risks covered by the so-called "all perils" endorsement and such other risks as the Mortgagee may reasonably require, in amounts (but in no event less than the initial stated principal amount of the Note) equal to the full replacement value of the Improvements, plus the cost of dibris removal, with full replacement cost endorsement and "agreed amount" endorsement;
 - (b) Comprehensive general public liability insurance against bodily injury and property damage in any way arising in connection with the Premises with use limits as the Morigages may reasonably require and in any event not less than \$3,000,000 single limit storage;
 - (c) Rent and rental value insurance (or, at the discretion of Morgagee, business interruption insurance) in amounts sufficient to pay during any period of up to con (1) for in which the Improvements may be damaged or destroyed (i) all projected annual rents derived from the Premises, and (ii) all amounts (including, but not limited to, all taxes, assessments, utility charges, operating expenses and insurance premiums) required herein to be paid by the Morgagor or by tenants of the Premises:
 - (d) Broad form boiler and machinery insurance on all equipment and objects costomarily covered by such insurance (if any thereof are located at the Premises), providing for full report and replacement cost coverage, and other insurance of the type and in amounts as the Mortgagee may reasonably require, but in any event not less than that customarily carried by persons owning or operating like properties:
 - (e) During the making of any alterations or improvements to the Premises (i) insurance covering claims based on the owner's contingent hability not covered by the insurance provided in subsection (b) above, and (ii) Workmen's Compensation insurance covering all persons engaged in making such alterations or improvements;
 - (f) Federal Flood Insurance in the maximum obtainable amount up to the amount of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured evidenced by the Note, if the Premises is in a "flood plain area" as defined by the Federal Insurance Administration pursuant to the Federal Flood Disaster Protection Act of 1973, as amended:
 - (g) If any part of the Premises is now or hereafter used for the sale or dispensing of beer, wine, spirits or any other alcoholic beverages, so-called "dram shop" or "inkeeper's liability" insurance against claims or liability arising directly or indirectly to persons or property on account of such sale or dispensing of beer, wine, spirits or other alcoholic beverages, including in such coverage loss of means of support, all in amounts as may be required by law or as the Mortgagee may specify, but in no event less than \$3,000,000 single limit coverage;

and Mortgagor shall at its own expense furnish such insurance appraisals as may be required by mortgagee from time to time (and in any event not less often than once every 5 years) to ascertain the full replacement cost of the Improvements for the purposes of Subsection (a) above.

- 5. Insurance Policies. All policies of insurance to be maintained and provided as required by Section 4 hereof shall
 - (a) Be in forms, companies and amounts reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, and all policies of casualty insurance shall have attached thereto mortgagee clauses or endorsements in favor of and with loss payable to Mortgagee;
 - (b) Contain endorsements that no act or negligence of the insured or any occupant and no occupancy or use of the irranses for purposes more hazardous than permitted by the terms of the policies will affect the validity or enforceability of such policies as against Mortgagee,
 - (c) Be written in amounts sufficient to prevent Mortgagor from becoming a co-insurer; and
 - (d) Provide for thirty (20) days' prior written notice of cancellation to Mortgagee;

and Mortgagor will deliver sli policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgagee, and in case of insurance policies about to expire the Mortgagor will deliver renewal policies not less than thirty (30) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

- 6. Deposits for Taxes and Insurance Premiums. In order to assure the payment of Taxes and insurance premiums payable with respect to the Premises as and when the same shall become one and payable:
 - (a) The Mortgagor shall deposit with the Mortgagee on the first day of wich and every month, commencing with the date the first payment of interest and/or principal and inverses shall become due on the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, an amount equal to:
 - (i) One-Twelfth (1/12) of the Taxes next to become due upon the Premises, provided that, in the case of the first such deposit, there shall be deposited in addition, an amount as estimated by Mortgagee which, when added to monthly deposits to be made thereafter as provided for herein, shall assure to Mortgagee's satisfaction that there will be sufficient funds on deposit to pay Taxes as they come due, plus
 - (ii) One-Twelfth (1/12) of the annual premiums on each policy of insurance upon the Premises; provided that, with the first such deposit there shall be deposited in addition, an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of such annual insurance premiums multiplied by the number of months elapsed between the date premiums on each policy were last paid to and including the date of deposit;

provided that the amount of such deposits (herein generally called "Tax and Insurance Deposits") shall be based upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of Taxes and premiums of insurance next to be payable;

- (b) The aggregate of the monthly Tax and Insurance Deposits, together with monthly payments of interest and/or principal and interest payable on the Note, shall be paid in a single payment each month, to be applied to the following items in the order stated:
 - (i) Taxes and insurance premiums;
 - (ii) Indebtedness Hereby Secured other than principal and interest on the Note;

- (iv) Amortization of the principal balance of the Note.
- (c) The Morigagee will, out of the Tax and Insurance Deposits, upon the presentation to the Morigagee by the Morigagor of the bills therefor, pay the insurance premiums and Taxes or will, upon presentation of receipted bills therefor, reimburse the Morigagor for such payments made by the Morigagor, provided that (i) if the total Tax and Insurance Deposits on hand shall not be sufficient to pay all of the Taxes and insurance premiums when the same shall become due, then the Morigagor shall pay to the Morigagee on demand any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, and (ii) if the total of such Deposits exceed the amount required to pay the Taxes and insurance premiums, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made for such items;
- (d) In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this Mortgage or in the Note, the Mortgagee may, at its option, without being required so to do, apply any Tax and Insurance Deposits on hand on any of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, in such order and manner as the Mortgagee may elect, and in such case the Mortgagor will replenish any Tax and Insurance Deposits so applied within 5 days after Mortgagee's demand, provided that when the Indebtedness Hereby Secured has been fully paid, then any remaining Tax and Insurance Deposits shall be paid to the Mortgagor;
- (e) All Tax and Insurance Deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, and shall be held in trust to be irrevocably applied for the purposes for which made as herein provided, and shall not be subject to the direction or control of the Mortgagor;
- (f) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, the Mortgagee shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of Taxes and insurance premiums any amounts deposited as Tax and Insurance Deposits unless the Mortgager, while no default exists hereunder, and within a reasonable time prior to the due date, shall have requested the Mortgagee in writing to make application of such Deposits on hand to the payment of the particular Taxes or insurance premiums for the payment of which such Deposits were made, accompanied by the bills therefor;
- (g) All Tax and Insurance Deposits in the hands of Mortgagee shall be held without allowance of interest and need not be kept separate and apart but they be commingled with any funds of the Mortgagee until applied in accordance with the provisions hereof

7. Proceeds of Insurance. The Mortgagor will give the Mortgagee prompt notice of any damage to or destruction of the Premises, and

- (a) In case of loss covered by policies of insurance, the Morigages for after entry of decree of foreclesure, the purchaser at the foreclosure sale or decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized at its option either (i) to settle and adjust any claim under such policies without the consent of the Morigagor, or (ii) allow the Morigagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss; provided that the Morigagor may itself adjust losses aggregating not in excess of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000); provided further that in any case the Morigagee shall, and is hereby authorized to, collect and receipt for any such insurance proceeds; and the expenses incurred by the Morigagee in the adjustment and collection of insurance proceeds shall be so much additional languages. Hereby Secured, and shall be reimbursed to the Morigagee upon demand;
- (b) In the event of any insured damage to or destruction of the Premises or any part there of (herein called an "Insured Casualty") and if, in the reasonable judgment of the Mortgagee, the Premises can be restored prior to Loan maturity, to an architectural and economic unit of the same character and not less valuable than the same was prior to the Insured Casualty, and adequately securing the outstanding balance of the Indebedness Hereby Secured, and the insurers do not deny liability to the insureds, then, if none of the Leases are subject to termination on account of such casualty and if no Event of Default as hereinafter defined shall have occurred and be then continuing, and if there was no event of default, whether continuing or not, at the time of occurrence of damage or destruction which resulted in said loss, the proceeds of insurance shall be applied to reimburse the Mortgagor for the cost of restoring, repairing, replacing or rebuilding (herein generally called "Restoring") the Premises or any part thereof subject to Insured Casualty, as provided for in Section 9 hereof;

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- (c) If, in the reasonable judgment of Mortgagee, the Premises cannot be restored to an architectural and economic unit as provided for in Subsection (b) above, then at any time from and after the Insured Casualty, upon thirty (30) days' written notice to Mortgagor. Mortgagee may declare the entire balance of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured to be, and at the expiration of such thirty (30) day period the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall be and become, immediately due and payable.
- (d) Except as provided for in Subsection (b) of this Section 7, Mortgagee shall apply the proceeds of insurance (including amounts not required for Restoring effected in accordance with Subsection (b) above consequent upon any Insured Casualty upon the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, in such order or manner as the Mortgagee may elect, provided that no premium or penalty shall be payable in connection with any prepayment of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured made out of insurance proceeds as aforesaid.
- (e) In the event that proceeds of insurance, if any, shall be made available to the Mortgagor for the Restoring of the Premises. Mortgagor hereby covenants to Restore the same to be of at least equal value and of substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction, all to be effected in accordance with gians and specifications to be first submitted to and approved by the Mortgagee.
- (f) Any portion of insurance proceeds remaining after payment in full of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall be pind to Morigagor or as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- (g) No interest shall be payable by Mortgagee on account of any insurance proceeds at any time held by Mortgagee.
- (h) Nothing contained in this Mortgage shall create any responsibility or liability upon the Mortgagee to (i) collect any proceeds of any policies of insurance, or (ii) Restore any portion of the Premises damaged or destroyed through any carise.
- 8. Condemnation. The Mortgagor will give Nortgagee prompt notice of any proceedings, instituted or threatened, seeking condemnation or taking by eminent fortisin or any like process (herein generally called a "Taking"), of all or any part of the Premises, including damages to grade, and:
 - (a) Mortgagor hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto Mortgagee the entire proceeds of any Award consequent upon any Taking:
 - (b) If, in the reasonable judgment of the Mortgagee, vir Premises can be restored to an architectural and economic unit of the same character and not less value of than the Premises prior to such Taking and adequately securing the outstanding balance of the Independents Hereby Secured, then if no Event of Default, as hereinafter defined, shall have occurred and be then continuing, the Award shall be applied to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of Restoring the portion of the Premises remaining after such Taking, as provided for in Section 9 hereof;
 - (c) If, in the reasonable judgment of Mortgagee, the Premises cannot be restored to an architectural and economic unit as provided for in Subsection (b) above, then at any time from and after the Taking, upon thirty (30) days' written notice to Mortgagor, Mortgagee may declare the entire bilance of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured to be, and at the expiration of such thirty (30) day period the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall be and become, immediately due and payable;
 - (d) Except as provided for in Subsection (b) of this Section 8, Mortgagee shall apply any Avard (including the amount not required for Restoration effected in accordance with Subsection (b) above) upon the Indebtedness Hereby Secured in such order or manner as the Mortgagee may elect; provided that no premium or penalty shall be payable in connection with any prepayment of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured made out of any Award as aforesaid;
 - (e) In the event that any Award shall be made available to the Mortgagor for Restoring the portion of the Premises remaining after a Taking. Mortgagor hereby covenants to Restore the remaining portion of the Premises to be of at least equal value and of substantially the same character as prior to such Taking, all to be effected in accordance with plans and specifications to be first submitted to and approved by the Mortgagee;
 - (f) Any portion of any Award remaining after payment in full of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall be paid to Mortgagor or as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction;
 - (g) No interest shall be payable by Mortgagee on account of any Award at any time held by Mortgagee, except to the extent that Mortgagee, at Mortgagee's sole option, elects to deposit any such Award in an interest-bearing account.



- 9. Disbursement of Insurance Proceeds and Condemnation Awards. In the event the Mortgagor is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds or any Award held by the Mortgagee, such proceeds shall be disbursed from time to time upon the Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion of the Restoring, with funds (or assurances satisfactory to the Mortgagee that such funds are available) sufficient in addition to the proceeds of insurance or Award, to complete the proposed Restoring, and with such architect's certificates, waivers of hen, contractor's sworn statements and such other evidence of costs and payments as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve, and the Mortgagee may, in any event, require that all plans and specifications for such Restoring be submitted to and approved by the Mortgagee prior to commencement of work; and in each case
 - (a) No payment made prior to the final completion of the Restoring shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed from time to time;
 - (b) Funds other than proceeds of insurance or the Award shall be disbursed prior to disbursement of such proceeds, and
 - (c) At all times the undibursed balance of such proceeds remaining in the hands of the Morigagee, together with funds deposited for the purpose or irrevocably committed to the satisfaction of the Morigagee by or on behalf of the Morigagee for the purpose, shall be at least sufficient in the reasonable judgment of the Morigagee to pay for the cost of completion of the Restoring, free and clear of all hens or claims for hen
- 10. Stamp Tax. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over the Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note, the Mortgagor shall pay such tax in the manner required by such law.
- 11. Prepayment Privilege. At such time as the Mortgagor is oft in default under the terms of the Note, or under the terms of this Mortgage, the Mortgagor shall have the privilege of making prepayments on the principal of the Note (in addition to the required payments thereunder) in accordance with the terms and conditions, if any, set forth in the Note, but not otherwise.
- 12. Effect of Extensions of Time, Amendments on Junior Liens and Others. Morragor covenants and agrees that:
 - (a) If the payment of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, or any part thereof, be extended or varied, or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter hable therefor, or interested in the Premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation of release, and their Publish, if any, and the hen and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force and effect; the right of resource against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding any such extension, variation or release;
 - (b) Any person, firm or corporation taking a junior mortgage or other hen upon the Premises or any interest therein, shall take the said hen subject to the rights of the Mortgagee herein to amend, modify and supplement this Mortgage, the Note and the Assignment and Construction Loan Agreement hereinafter referred to, and to vary the rate of interest and the method of computing the same, and to impose additional fees and other charges, and to extend the maturity of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, in each and every case without obtaining the consent of the holder of such junior hen and without the hen of this Mortgage losing its priority over the rights of any such junior hen;
 - (c) Nothing in this Section contained shall be construed as waiving any provision of Section 17 hereof which provides, among other things, that it shall constitute an Event of Default if the Premises be sold, conveyed or encumbered.

- 13. Effect of Changes in Tax Laws. In the event of the enactment after the date hereof by any legislative authority having jurisdiction of the Premises of any law deducting from the value of land for the purposes of taxation, any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by the Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the Mortgagee's interest in the Premises, or the method of collecting taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee the payment by Mortgagor of any such taxes or assessments shall be unlawful, then the Mortgagee may, by notice to the Mortgagor, declare the entire principal balance of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured and all accrued interest to be due and payable on a date specified in such notice, not less than 180 days after the date of such notice, and the Indebtedness Hereby Secured and all accrued interest shall then be due and payable without premium or penalty on the date so specified in such notice.
- 14. Mortgegee: Performance of Mortgagor's Obligations. In case of default therein, the Mortgagee either before or after acceleration of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured or the foreclosure of the lien hereof, and during the period of redemption, if six, may, but shall not be required to, make any payment or perform any act herein-er-in-the-Construction Local Agreement-hereinester researced to, which is required of the Mortgagor (whether or not the Mortgagor is personally liable therefor) in any form and manner deemed expedient to the Mortgagee, and in connection therewith.
 - (a) The Mortgagee may, but shall not be required to, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, of any and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, an edeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting the Premises, or contest any tax or assessment;
 - (b) Mortgagee may, but shall not be required to, complete construction, furnishing and equipping of the Improvements upon the Premises and rent, operate and manage the Premises and such Improvements and pay operating costs and expenses, including management fees, of every kind and nature in connection therewith, so that the Premises and Improvements shall be operational and usable for their intended purposes;
 - (c) All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized or authorized by any other instrument evidencing or securing the indebtedness Hereby Secured, and all rapenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees and any other monies advanced by the Mortgagee to protect the Premises and the lien hereof, or to complete construction, furnishing and equipping, or to rent, operate and manage the Premises and such improvements, or to pay any such operating costs and expenses thereof, or to keep the Premises and Improvements operational and usable for their intended purposes, shall be so much additional indebtedness Hereby Secured, whether or not they exceed the amount of the Note, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice, and with interest thereby at the Default Rate specified in the Note (herein called the "Default Rate"):
 - (d) Inaction of the Mortgagee shall never be considered a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of the Mortgagor;
 - (e) The Mortgagee, in making any payment hereby authorized (i) relating to taxes and assexingents, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate, without inquiry into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale forfeiture, tax ben or title or claim thereof, (ii) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for ben which may be asserted, or (iii) in connection with the completion of construction, furnishing or equipping of the Improvements or the Premises or the rental, operation or management of the Premises or the payment of operating costs and expenses thereof, Mortgagee may do so in such amounts and to such persons as Mortgagee may deem appropriate, and may enter into such contracts therefor as Mortgagee may deem appropriate or may perform the same itself.
- 15. Inspection of Premises. The Morigagee shall have the right to inspect the Premises at all reasonable times, and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 16. Financial Statements. The Mortgagor will, within ninery (90) days after the end of each fiscal year of the Mortgagor and of each guarantor and each tenant epocified by Mortgagos, furnish to the Mortgagos at the place where interest thereon is then payable, financial and operating statements of the Premises and of the guarantor

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and each such tenant for such fiscal year, all in reasonable detail and in any event including such itemized statement of receipts and disbursements as shall enable Mortgagee to determine whether any default exists hereunder or under the Note, and in connection therewith by Mortgagor's beneficiary (

- (a) Such financial and operating statements shall be prepared and certified at the expense of Mortgagor in such manner as may be acceptable to the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee may, by notice in writing to the Morigagor, require that the same be prepared and certified, pursuant to audit, by a firm of independent certified public accountants satisfactory to Mortgagee, in which case such accountants shall state whether or not, in their opinion, any default or Event of Default exists hereunder or under the Note, and
- (b) If the statements furnished shall not be prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles consistently applied, or if Mortgagor fails to furnish the same when due. Mortgagee may audit or cause to be audited the books of the Premises and/or the Mortgagor and of each Guarantor and each such tenant, at Mortgagor's expense, and the costs of such audit shall be so much additional Indebtedness Hereby Secured bearing interest at the Default Rate until paid, and payable upon demand.
- 17. Restrictions on 1 (29) fer. Subject to the provisions of Section 18 hereof, it shall be an immediate Event of Default hereunder if, without the prior written consent of the Mortgagee, any of the following shall occur, and in any event Mortgagee may condition its consent upon such increase in rate of interest payable upon the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, change in monthly payments thereon, change in maturity thereof and/or the payment of a fee, all as Mortgagee may in its sole discretion require:
 - (a) If the Mortgagor shall creat; effect, contract for, commit to or consent to or shall suffer or permit any conveyance, sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of the Premises or any part thereof, or interest therein, excepting only sales or other dispositions of Collateral as defined in Section 19 (nevern called "Obsolete Collateral") no longer useful in connection with the operation of the Premises; provide/that prior to the sale or other disposition thereof, such Obsolete Collateral shall have been replaced by Collateral, subject to the first and prior lien hereof, of at least equal value and utility:
 - (b) If the Mortgagor is a trustee, then if any beneficiary of the Mortgagor shall create, effect, contract for. commit to or consent to, or shall suffer or permit, any side, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage. security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of sych beneficiary's beneficial interest in the Morigagor:
 - (c) If the Mortgagor is a corporation, or if any corporation is a beneficiary of a trustee mortgagor, then if any shareholder of such corporation shall create, effect, contract for, commit to or consent to or shall suffer or permit any sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of any such shareholder's shares in such corporation; provided that if such corporation is a corporation whose stock is publicly traded on a national securities exchange of on the "Over The Counter" market, then this Section 17(c) shall be inapplicable;
 - (d) If the Mortgagor is a partnership or joint venture, or if any beneficiary of a trus ee Mortgagor is a partnership or joint venture, then if any general partner or joint venturer in such partnership or joint venture shall create, effect or consent to or shall suffer or permit any sale, assignment transfer lien, pledge, morigage, security interest or other encumbrance or alienation of any part of the partnership interest or joint venture interest, as the case may be, of such partner or joint venturer; or
 - (e) If there shall be any change in control (by way of transfers of stock ownership, partnership interests or otherwise) in any general partner which directly or indirectly controls or is a general partner of a partnership or joint venture beneficiary as described in Subsection 17(d) above:

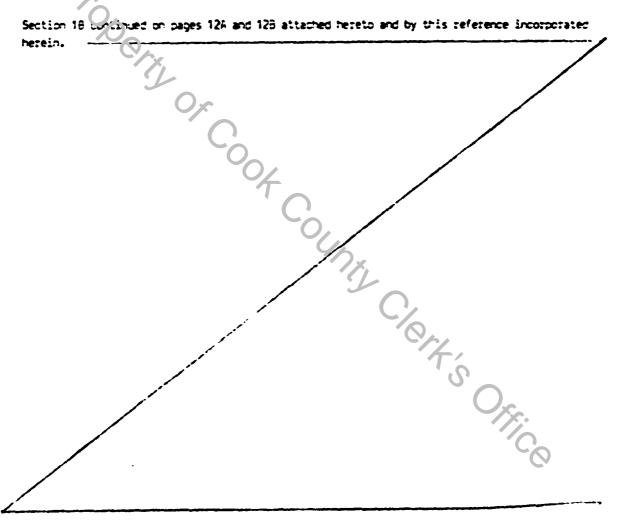
in each case whether any such conveyance, sale, assignment, transfer, lien, pledge, mortgage, security interest, encumbrance or alienation is effected directly, indirectly, voluntarily or involuntarily, by operation of law or otherwise, provided that provisions of this Section 17 shall be operative with respect to, and shall be binding upon, any persons who, in accordance with the terms hereof or otherwise, shall acquire any part of or interest in or encumbrance upon the Premises, or such beneficial interest in, share of stock of or partnership or joint venture interest in the Mortgagor or any beneficiary of a Trustee Mortgagor, and provided further that no consent by

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Mortgagee to, or any waiver of, any event or condition which would otherwise constitute an Event of Default under this Section 1", shall constitute a consent to or a waiver of any other or subsequent such event or condition or a waiver of any right, remedy or power of Mortgagee consequent thereon

- 18. Permitted Transfers. The provisions of Section 17 hereof shall not apply to any of the following
 - (a) Liens securing the Indebtedness Hereby Secured,
 - (b) The lien of current real estate taxes and assessments not in default,
 - (c) Transfers of the Premises or part thereof, or interest therein or any beneficial interests therein of thick, or partnership or yount conture interests, as the case may be, in the Montpaper, or any beneficiary of a lightnessee Montpaper by or on behalf of an owner thereof who is deceased or declared judicially incompetent, to such owner's heirs, legaters, devisees, executors, administrators, estate, personal representatives and for committee, provided, nowever, that Montpaper is given written notice of such transfer and there is paid to Montpaper a \$1,000.00 transfer fee per occurrence per transferee.



- 19. Uniform Commercial Code. This Mortgage constitutes a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code of the State in which the Premises is located (herein called the "Code") with respect to any part of the Premises which may or might now or hereafter be or be deemed to be personal property, fixtures or property other than real estate (all herein called "Collateral"), all of the terms, provisions, conditions and agreements contained in this Mortgage pertain and apply to the Collateral as fully and to the same extent as to any other property comprising the Premises; and the following provisions of this Section 19 shall not limit the generality or applicability of any other provision of this Mortgage, but shall be in addition thereto:
 - (a) The Mortgagor (being the Debtor as that term is used in the Code) is and will be the true and lawful owner of the Collateral, subject to no liens, charges or encumbrances other than the lien hereof;

- So long as at all times prior to the Maturity Date, Jack L. Rajchenbach (d) is a general partner of Mortgagor's beneficiary and owns and controls not less than a 15% interest (measured by both percentage of capital and allocation of profits) in Mortgagor's beneficiary, and provided that at least five (5) business days prior to the date of any proposed transfer under this Subsection 18(d) Mortgagee is given written notice of such proposed transfer, together with transfer fee in the amount of \$1,000.00 per occurrence per transferee, (i) transfers of general partnership interests by any general partner of Mortgagor's beneficiary to another general partner of Mortgagor's beneficiary, and (ii) transfers of general partnership interests by any general partner of Mortgagor's beneficiary to any member of said general partner's immediate family or to trusts or custodial accounts created for the benefit of any member of said general partner's immediate family. For purposes of this Subsection 18(d) the term "immediate family" shall be limited to a spouse, child, brother, sister, nephew or niece of a general partner of Mortgager's beneficiary:
- (e) Secondary lient upon the Premises and/or upon the beneficial interest of Mortgagor (herein called "Permitted Secondary Liens") securing indebtedness for coney borrowed on a non-recourse basis (herein called "Permitted Secondary Debt") provided that:
 - subject and subordinate in all respects to all liens securing the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, including, but not limited to, the lien hereof and the lien of the Assignment; all instruments and documents evidencing and securing such Permitted Secondary Debt and such Permitted Secondary Liens are in form and content reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee in all respects; and the lender of the Permitted Secondary Debt (herein called the "Secondary Lender") executes and delivers a subordination and standby agreement in form satisfactory to Mortgagee subordinating the Permitted Secondary Liens to all liens securing the Indebtedness Hereby Secured;
 - (ii) At the time of creation of the Permitted Secondary Debt, the quotient obtained by dividing (A) the annual net operating income (without deducting charges for depreciation and principal and interest payments under this Note or any other Permitted Secondary Debt), derived from the operation of the Premises for the immediately preceding full calendar year (as determined by Mortgagor and approved by Mortgagee) by (B) the then aggregate annual payments of principal and interest payable under the Note and any other note and/or other documents evidencing and securing the Permitted Secondary Debt, exceeds 1.25;
 - (iii) The aggregate of the amount disbursed by Mortgagee under the Note plus the maximum principal balance of the Permitted Secondary Debt does not then exceed \$5,000,000.

(iv) Mortgagor or Mortgagor's beneficiary notifies Mortgagee in writing prior to the incurring of any proposed Permitted Secondary Debt and Permitted Secondary Liens and obtains the consent of Mortgagee thereto, which consent shall not be withheld provided that the provisions and conditions of this Subsection 18(e) are satisfied and complied with;

- (v) Mortgagor pays to Mortgagee, Mortgagee's servicing agent and Mortgagee's counsel all reasonable fees and disbursements incurred in the preparation, negotiation, review and approval of all documentation in connection with the processing of the Permitted Secondary Liens;
- (vi) The Secondary Lender is a reputable financial institution testionably acceptable to Mortgagee; and
- Event of Default or event which with the giving of notice or passage of time, or both, would constitute such an Event of Default exists and is then continuing;
- (f)An operating lease of the Premises (the "Lease") by Mortgagor to an operating corporation, management company or other entity or person (the "Lessee") provided that (i) no Event of Default or event which with the giving of notice or passage of time, or both, would constitute such an Event of Default exists (no is then continuing, (ii) the Lease is in form and content satisfactory to Mortgagee, (iii) the Lessee or principal owners thereof. as the case may be, is financially responsible and experienced in the operation and management of state licensed nursing homes; (iv) the Lessee executes a Subordination Agreement in form and content satisfactory to Most sagee in all respects and prepared by Mortgagee; (v) the Lease is specifically assigned to Mortgagee by a collateral assignment in form and content satisfactory to Mortgagee in all respects and prepared by Mortgagee; and (vl) Mortgagor pays to Mortgagee all reasonable fees, costs and distresements (including reasonable attorney's fees) incurred by Mortgages in connection with this Subsection 18(f). -



- (b) The Collateral is to be used by the Mortgagor solely for business purposed, being installed upon the Premises for Mortgagor's own use or as the equipment and furnishings furnished by Mortgagor, as landioid, to tenants of the Premises:
- (c) The Collateral will be kept at the Real Estate and will not be removed therefrom without the consent of the Mortgagee (being the Secured Party as that term is used in the Code) by Mortgagor or any other person, and the Collateral may be affixed to the Real Estate but will not be affixed to any other real estate.
- (d) The only persons having any interest in the Premises are the Morigagor, Morigagee and persons occupying the Premises as tenants only:
- (e) No Financing Statement covering any of the Collateral or any proceeds thereof is on file in any public office except pursuant hereto, and Mortgagor will at its own cost and expense, upon demand, furnish to the Mortgagee such further information and will execute and deliver to the Mortgagee such financing statement and other documents in form satisfactory to the Mortgagee, and will do all such acts and things as the Mortgagee may at any time or from time to time reasonably request or as may be necessary or appropriate to establish and maintain a perfected security interest in the Cullateral as security for the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, subject to no adverse liens or encumbrances, and the Mortgagor will pay the cost of filing the same or filing or recording such financing statements or other documents, and this instrument, in all public offices whenever filing or recording is deemed by the Mortgagee to be necessary or desirable.
- (f) Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default hereunder (regardiess of whether the Code has been enacted in the jurisdiction where rights or remedies are asserted) and at any time thereafter (such Event of Default not having previously been cured), the Mortgagee at its option may declare the Indebtedness Hereby Secured immediately due and payable, all as more fully set forth in Section 20 hereof, and thereupon Mortgagee shall have the remedies of a secured party under the Code, including without limitation the right to take immediate and exclusive possession of the Collateral, or any part thereof, and for that purpose may, so far as the Mortgagor can give juthority therefor, with or without judicial process, enter (if this can be done without breach of the peace) upon any place which the Collateral or any part thereof may be situated and remove the same therefrom (provided that if the Collateral is affixed to real estate, such removal shall be subject to the conditions stated in the Code);
- (g) The Mortgagee shall be entitled to hold, maintain, preserve and prepare the Collateral for sale, until disposed of, or may propose to retain the Collateral, smorter to the Mortgagor's right of redemption, if any, in satisfaction of the Mortgagor's obligations as provided in the Code, provided that (i) the Mortgagee without removal may render the Collateral unusable and dispose of the Collateral on the Premises, and (ii) the Mortgagee may require the Mortgagor to assemble the Collateral and make it available to the Mortgagee for its possession at a place to be designated by Mortgagee which is reasonably convenient to both parties;
- (h) The Mortgagee will give Mortgagor at least five (5) days' notice of the time and place of any public sale thereof or of the time after which any private sale or any other intended disposition thereof is made and the requirements of reasonable notice shall be met if such notice is mailed, by certified mail or equivalent, postage prepaid, to the address of the Mortgagor determined as provided in Section 32 hereof, at least five (5) days before the time of the sale or disposition;
- (i) The Mortgagee may buy at any public sale, and if the Collateral is a type customarily sold (n) recognized market or is of a type which is the subject of widely distributed standard price quotations. Mortgagee may buy at any private sale, and any such sale may be held as part of and in conjunction with any foreclosure sale of the Real Estate comprised within the Premises, the Collateral and Real Estate to be sold as one lot if Mortgagee so elects;
- (j) The net proceeds realized upon any such disposition, after deduction for the expenses of retaking, holding, preparing for sale, selling or the like, and the reasonable attorneys' fees and legal expenses incurred by Mortgagee, shall be applied in satisfaction of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured; and the Mortgagee will account to the Mortgagor for any surplus realized on such disposition;
- (k) The remedies of the Mortgagee hereunder are cumulative and the exercise of any one or more of the remedies provided for herein or under the Code shall not be construed as a waiver of any of the other remedies of the Mortgagee, including having the Collateral deemed part of the realty upon any foreclosure thereof, so long as any part of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured remains unsatisfied;

 - (b) If an Event of Default pursuant to Section 17 hereof shall occur and be continuing without notice or grace of any kind, or
 - (c) If default is made in the maintenance and delivery to Mortgagee of insurance required to be maintained and delivered hereunder, without notice or grace of any kind, or
 - (d) If (and for the purpose of this Section 20(d) only, the term Mortgagor shall mean and include not only Mortgagor but any beneficiary of a Trustee Mortgagor and each person who, as guarantor, co-maker or other wise shall be or become hable for or obligated upon all or any part of the Indebtedness Hereby Secured or any of the covenants or agreements contained herein or in the Construction Loan Agreement).
 - (i) The 'torteagor shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy under the Bankruptcy Code of the United States of 2015 similar law, state or federal, now or hereafter in effect, or
 - (ii) The Mortgague shall file an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or
 - (iii) Within sixty (60) days after the filing against Mortgagor of any involuntary proceedings under such Bankrupicy Code or similar law, such proceedings shall not have been vacated or stayed, or
 - (iv) The Mortgagor shall be adjusticated a bankrupt, or a trustee or receiver shall be appointed for the Mortgagor or for all or the motion part of the Mortgagor's property or the Premises, in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of all or the major part of the Mortgagor's property or the Premises in any involuntary proceeding for the protection, reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Mortgagor, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacaled or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within sixty (60) days, or
 - (v) The Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all or the major part of its property, or the Premises, or
 - (e) If any default shall exist under the provisions of Section 26 Lerech, or under the Assignment referred to therein; or
 - (f) If any default chall exist-under the provisions of Section 20 hereef. under the Construction Lean Agreement referred to therein; or
 - (g) If any representation made by or on behalf of Morigagor in connection with the Indebtedness Hereby Secured shall prove untrue in any material respect; or
 - (h) If default shall continue for 15 days after notice thereof by Mortgager to Mortgagor in the due and punctual performance or observance of any other agreement or condition herein or in the Note contained, provided that if such default is not susceptible of cure within such 15-day period, such 15-day period such be extended to the extent necessary to permit such curefif, but only if, (i) Mortgagor shall commence such cure within such 15-day period and shall thereafter prosecute such cure to completion, diligently and without delay, and (ii) no other Event of Default shall occur; or
 - (i) If the Premises shall be abandoned;
 - (j) Any default by Mortgagor or Mortgagor's beneficiary under any documents or instruments evidencing or securing any Permitted Secondary Debt.
 - (k) Any default by Mortgagor or Mortgagor's beneficiary under the Lease, if any, described in Subsection 18(f) herein.

then the Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagee hereunder, to declare, without further notice all Indebtedness Hereby Secured to be immediately due and payable, whether or not such default is thereafter remedied by the Mortgagor, and the Mortgagee may immediately proceed to foreclose this Mortgage and/or exercise any right, power or remedy provided by this Mortgage, the Note, the Assignment or by law or in equity conferred.

- 21. Foreclosure. When the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, the Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such Indebtedness or part thereof and in connection therewith:
 - (a) In any suit or proceeding to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale, all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on health of the Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraisers' fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, and similar data and assurances with respect to title, as the Mortgagee may deem reasonably ne usuary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at sales which may be had pursuant to such decree the true conditions of the title to or the value of the Premises, and
 - (b) All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this Section mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the hen of this Morigage, including the fees of any attorney employed by the Morigage in any hitigation or proceedings affecting this Morigage, the Note or the Premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparation for the commencement or defense of any officeeding or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by the Morigagor, with interest thereon at the Default Rate.
- 22. Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any Preclosure sale of the Premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority. First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in Section 21 hereof. Second, all other items which, under the terms hereof, constitute Indebtedness Hereby Secured additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest on such items as herein provided. Third, to interest remaining unpaid upon the Note; Fourth, to the principal remaining unpaid upon the Note, and lastly, any overplus to the Minigagor, and its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 23. Receiver. Morrgagor consents and agrees that:
 - (a) Upon, or at any time after, the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Morigage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the Premises:
 - (b) Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver, and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestery or not, and the Mortgagee hereunder, or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver:
 - (c) Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, if any, whether there be a redemption or not, as well as during any further times when the Morigagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collection of such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of said period:

- 25. Waiver. The Moittegar hereby convenants and agrees that it will not at any time insist upon or plead, or in any manner whatever claim or take any advantage of, any stay, exemption or extension law or any so-called "Moratorium Law" now or a any time hereafter in force, nor claim, take or insist upon the benefit or advantage of or from any law now or hereafter in force providing for the valuation or appraisement of the Premises, or any part thereof, prior to any sale or sale, thereof to be made pursuant to any provisions herein contained, or to decree, judgment or order of any court of competent jurisdiction, or, after such sale or sales, claim or exercise any rights under any statute now or hereafter in force to redeem the property so sold, or any part thereof, or relating to the marshalling thereof, upon foreclosure sale or other enforcement hereof, and without limiting the foregoing.
 - (a) The Mortgagor hereby expressly waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this Mortgage, on its own behalf and on behalf of each and every person, excepting only decree or judgment creditors of the Mortgagor acquiring any interest or title to the Premise-or beneficial interest in Mortgagor subsequent to the disc bereef, it being the intent hereof that any and all such rights of redemption of the Mortgagor and of all others, persons are and shall be deemed to be hereby waived to the full extent permitted by the provisions of Chapter 110, Para. 12-124 and Para. 12-125 of the Illinois Statutes or other applicable law or replacement statutes;
 - (b) The Mortgagor will not invoke or utilize any such law or laws or otherwise hinder, delay or impede the execution of any right, power or remedy herein or otherwise granted on delegated to the Mortgager but will suffer and permit the execution of every such right, power and remedy as though no such law or laws had been made or enacted; and
 - (c) If the Morigagor is a trustee, Morigagor represents that the provisions of this Section (including the waiver of redemption rights) were made at the express direction of Morigagor's beneficiaries and the persons having the power of direction over Morigagor, and are made on behalf of the Trust Estate of Morigagor and all beneficiaries of Morigagor, as well as all other persons mentioned above.
- 26. Assignment. As further security for the Indebtedness Hereby Secured, the Mortgagor has, concurrently herewith, executed and delivered to the Mortgagee a separate instrument (herein called the "Assignment") dated as of the date hereof, wherein and whereby, among other things, the Mortgagor has assigned to the Mortgagee all of the rents, issues and profits, and/or any and all Leases and/or the rights of management of the Premises, all as therein more specifically set forth, which said Assignment is hereby incorporated herein by reference as fully and with the same effect as if set forth herein at length; and in connection with the foregoing:

- 29. Business Loan. It is understood and agreed that the loan evidenced by the Note and secured hereby is a business loan within the purview of section 6404 of Chapter 17 of Illinois Revised Statutes (or any substitute, amended, or replacement statutes) transacted solely for the purpose of carrying on or acquiring the business of the Mortgagor or, if the Mortgagor is a trustee, for the purpose of carrying on or acquiring the business of the beneficiaries of the Mortgagor as contemplated by said Section.
- 30. Construction Lean Agreement. 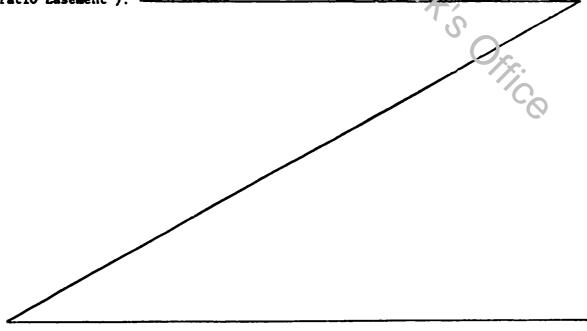

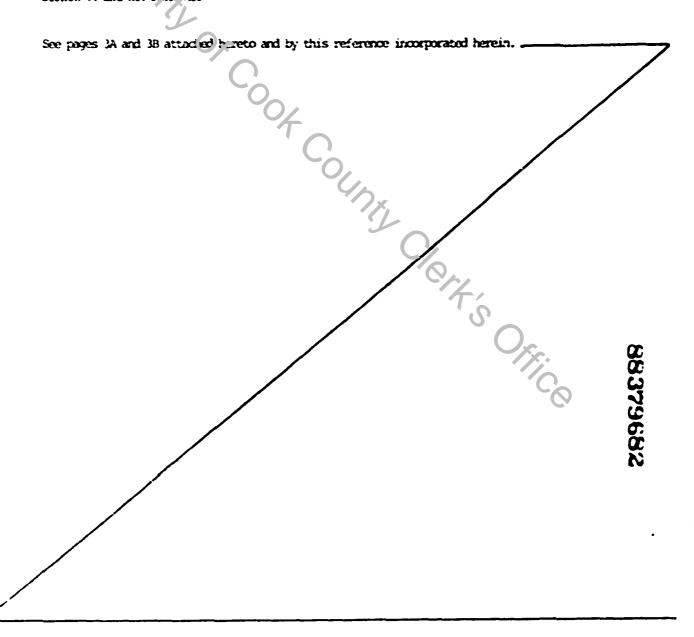

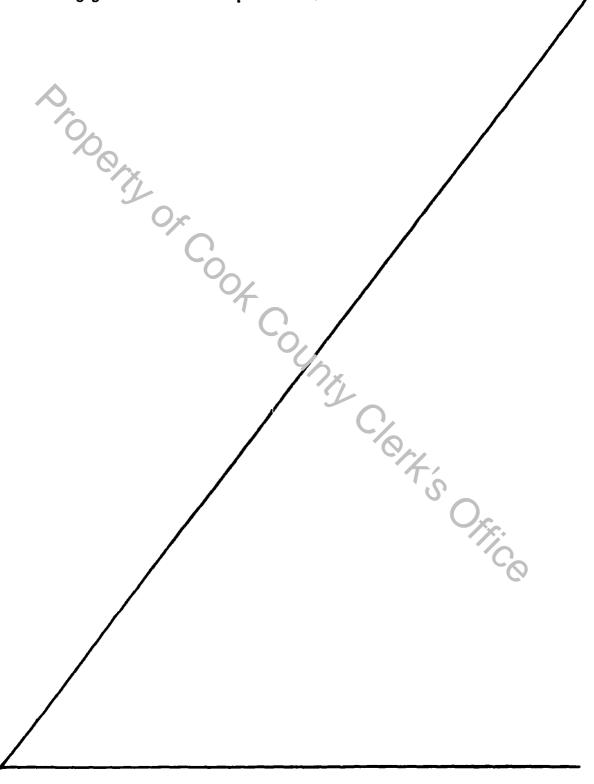
