PLEA

GUILTY, and the court being satisfied that there is a factual basis for the plea. NOLO CONTENDERE, NOT GUILTY

FINDING & JUDGMENT

There being a finding of GUILTY. Defendant is discharged.

Defendant has been convicted as charged of the offense(s) of knowingly, willfully, and unlawfully, with intent to defraud, did falsely make and forge an endorsement and signature on a Treasury Check of the United States with a face value not exceeding \$500.00.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 510(a) (1).

SENTENCE OR PROBATION ORDER

The court asked whether defendant had anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced. Because no sufficient cause to the contrary was shown or appeared to the court, the court adjudged the defendant guilty as charged and convicted and ordered that

IT IS ADJUDGED THAT on each of Counts 3 and 4 of the Indictment the defendant is placed on probation for a period of THREE (3) YEARS, on condition that she comply with the general conditions of probation and that she make restitution in the sum of \$24,924.00 payable in such amounts per month as are determined by the probation officer.

Said sentence on each of Counts 3 and 4 to run concurrently with each other.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED THAT defendant shall serve 100 hours of Community Service as determined by the Probation Officer.

On Government's oral motion remaining counts are hereby dismissed.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

In addition to the special conditions of probation imposed above, it is hereby ordered that the general conditions of probation set out on the reverse side of this judgment be imposed. The Court may change the conditions of probation, reduce or extend the period of probation, and at any time during the probation period or within a maximum probation period of five years permitted by law, may issue a warrant and revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period
