THAT, WHEREAS the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the legal holder or holders of the Instalment Note hereinafter described, said legal holder or holders being herein referred to as HOLDERS OF THE NOTE, in the PRINCIPAL SUM OF Two Hundred Thousand and 00/100----- DOLLARS

evidenced by one certain Instalment Note of the Mortgagors of even date herewith, made payable to BEARER \_\_\_\_\_

and delivered, in and by which said Note the Mortgagors promise to pay the said principal sum and interest \_\_\_\_\_

on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of (\*) per cent per annum in instalments as follows: Int only Dollars on the 10th day of September 88 and Int only Dollars on the 10th day of each successive month thereafter until said note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and

interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 10th day of August 19 89. All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the maximum rate permitted by law, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in

Countryside Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of State Bank of Countryside in said City.

This Trust Deed and the note secured hereby are not assumable and become immediately due and payable in full upon vesting of title in other than the grantor(s) of the Trust Deed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situation lying and being in the

COUNTY OF Cook AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

Lots 44, 61, 63, 64 in Hilltop Estates Subdivision, being a Subdivision in part of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 11 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois

which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "premises."

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagors may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, major beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters. All of the foregoing are declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, and it is agreed that all similar apparatus, equipment or articles hereafter placed in the premises by the mortgagors or their successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitutes secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

9. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

10. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.

11. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

12. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be liable for any acts or omissions herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

13. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien hereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note, representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, written representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as the makers thereof; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed by the persons herein designated as makers thereof.

14. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, then Chicago Title and Trust Company shall be the first Successor in Trust, and in case of its resignation, inability or refusal to act the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be second Successor in Trust. Any successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

15. This Trust Deed and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include all such persons and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this Trust Deed.

COMMUNIQUE

b. Mortgagor shall pay each item of indebtedness heretofore mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof, at the option of the holders of the note, and without notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness accrued by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding any entry in the note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable immediately in the case of default in making payment of any instalment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement contained.

3. The Trustee of the holders of the note hereby secures making any payment in early authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appraiser, public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or other claim thereof.

3. Mortgagors shall keep all building and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against damage by fire, lightning or under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of monies sufficient to deliver prompt and complete payment of the same.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSIGNED AND AGREED THAT

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said trustee, his successors and assigns, forever; for the purposes and upon the terms and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Familiar Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the largess do hereby expressly release and waive.
