the payment of all expenses and the care and management of said premises, including taxes and assessments, and the interest on
incumbrances, if any, which may in said attorney's judgment be deemed proper and advisable, hereby ratifying all that said
attorney may do by virtue hereof.

authority conferred upon and vested in it as such trustee (and said "Trustee" hereby warrants that it possesses full power and
authority to execute this instrument), and it is expressly understood and agreed that no indenture or note or other instrument shall be construed
as creating any liability on the said First Party or on said "TRUSTEE", personally to pay the said principal note or any interest due
thereon, or any indebtedness accruing hereunder, or in performing any covenant either express or implied herein contained, all such liability, if any,
being expressly waived by Trustee and by every person now or hereafter claiming any right or security hereunder, and that sole as the First Party
