### And Said Mortgagor covenants and agrees:

To keep said premises in good repair, and not to do, or permit to be done, upon said premises, anything that may impair the value thereof, or of the security intended to be affected by virtue of this instrument; not to suffer any lien of mechanics men or material men to attach to said premises; to pay to the Mortgagee, as hereinafter provided, until said note is fully paid, (1) a sum suffi-cient to pay all taxes and assessments on said premises, or any tax or assessment that may be levied by authority of the State of IIlineis, or of the county, town, village, or city in which the said land is situate, upon the Mortgagor on account of the ownership thereof; (2) a sum sufficient to keep all buildings that may at any time be on said premises, during the continuance of said indebtedness, insured for the benefit of the Mortgagee in such forms of insurance, and in such amounts, as may be required by the Mortgagee.

And the said Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:

(b) All payments mentioned in the preceding subsection of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Mortgagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagee to the following items in the order set

(i) ground rents, if any, taxes, special assessments, fire, and other hazard insurance premiums;

(ii) interest on the note secured hereby;

(iii) amortization of the principal of the said note; and (iv) inte charges.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgageo may collect a "late charge" not to exceed four cents (40) for each dollar (\$1) for each payment more than lifteen (15) days in arrears, to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.

If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under subsection (a) of the proceding paragraph shall exceed the amount of the payments actually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxes, and assessments, or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgagest property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

That if the premises, or any part thereof, be condemned under any power of eminent domain, or acquired for a public use, the damages, proceeds, and the consideration for such acquisition, to the extent of the full amount of indebtedness upon this Mortgage, and the Note secured hereby remaining unpaid, are hereby assigned by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee and shall be paid forthwith to the Mortgagee to be applied by it on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not.

The Mortgagor Furth or Agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereay ...t be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act, within ninety(90) this from the date hereof (writton statement of any officer of the Department of Housing and Lorlan Development or authorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the ninety(90) time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility), the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this option may not be exercised by the Mortgagee when the ineligibility for insurance and a the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgagee's failure to comit the mortgage insurance premium to the Department of Howing and Urban Development.

In the Event of default in making any monthly payment provided for herein and in the note secured horeby for a period ( f thirty (30) days after the due date thereof, or in case of a breach of any other covenant or agreement herein stipulated, then the whole of said principal sum remaining unpaid together with accrued interest thereon, shall, at the election of the Mortgagee, without notice, become immediately due and payable.

And in The Event that the whole of said debt is declared to be due, the Mortgagee shall have the right immediately to foreclose this mortgage, and upon filing of any bill for that purpose, the court in which such bill is filed may at any time thereafter, either before or after sale, and without notice to the said Mortgagor, or any party claiming under said Mortgagor, and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the person or persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, at the time of such applications for appointment of a receiver, or for an order to place Mortgagee in possession of the premises and without regard to the value of said premises or whether the same shall be then occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption, as a homestead, enter an order placing the Mortgagee in possession of the premises, or appoint a receiver for the benefit of the Mortgagee with power to collect the rents, issues, and profits of the said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, and such rents, issues, and profits when collected may be applied toward the payment of the indebtedness, costs, taxes, insurance and other items necessary for the protection and preservation of the property.

Whenever the said Mortgagee shall be placed in possession of the above described premises under an order of a court in which an action is pending to foreclose this mortgage or a subsequent mortgage, the said Mortgagee, in its descretion, may: keep the said premises in good ropair; pay such current or back taxes and assessments as may be due on the said premises; pay for and maintain such insurance in such amounts as shall have been required by the Mortgagee; lease the said premises to the Mortgagor or others upon such terms and conditions, either within or beyond any period of redemption, as are approved by the court; collect and receive the rents, issues, and profits for the use of the premises hereinabove described; and employ other persons and expend itself such amounts as are reasonably necessary to carry out the provisions of this paragraph.

An in Case of Forcelosure of this mortgage by said Mortgagee in any court of law or equity, a reasonably sum shall be allowed for the solicitor's fees, and stenegraphers' fees of the complainant in such proceeding, and also for all outlays for documentary evidence and the cost of a complete abstract of title for the purpose of such foreclosure; and in case of any other suit, or legal proceeding, wherein the Mortgagee shall be made a party thereto by reason of this mortgage, its costs and expenses, and the reasonable fees and charges of the attorneys or solicitors of the Mortgagee, so made parties, for services in such suit or proceedings, shall be a further lien and charge upon the said premises under this mortgage, and all such expenses shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and be allowed in any decree foreclosing this mortgage.

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## MORTGAGE ASSUMPTION RIDER

The Mortgage is amended to add the following:

\*The mortgagee shall, with the prior approval of the Federal Housing Commissioner, or his designee, declare all sums secured by this mortgage to be immediately due and payable if 311 or a part of the property is sold or otherwise transferred (other than by devise, descent or operation of law) by the mortgagor, pursuant to a contract of sale executed not later than 12 months after the date on which the mortgage is executed, to a purchaser whose credit has not been approved in accordance with the requirements of the Commissioner. (If the property is not the principal or secondary residence of the mortgagor, "24 months" must be substituted for "12 months.")
