#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

## Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lance of time

# Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Putchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors, .- The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's Henor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (1) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### (1) Place For Filling Notice: Form. -

- (1) Place for filing.-The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed--
  - (A) Under State Laws. --
  - (I) Real Property in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, In which the property subject to the fien is shuated; and
  - (ii) Personal Property. -- In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or
- (8) With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to the lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

- (g) Refling Of Notice. for purposes of this section-
- (1) Conoral Rule, Unless notice of fien is relied in the manner prescribed in datagraph (2) during the required reliting period, such notice of lien shall be freated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (1)) after the expiration of such reliting period
- (2) Place For Filing.—A notice of lien related during the required refiling period shall be effective only-(A) if-
- (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (iii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an Index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4); and

## Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal rovenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Salisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become logally unenforceable, or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all releast in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (Ficture), grany extension of such time), and that is in accordan's with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and furn of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations
