certificate of sale and a duplicate thereof to be recorded with the Recorder of Deeds or Cook County, Illinois.

It is further ordered that upon request by the successful bidder, the Special Commissioner shall execute and deliver to the successful bidder, a deed sufficient to convey title provided that all required payments have been made pursuant to Illinois Revises Statues Chapter 110, Section 15-1509.

That the Veteran's Administration, as assignee of the bidder is entitled to possession of the premises, commonly known as:
