

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable poneity, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real for personal, belonging to such person. (101)

Sec. 6322.-Period-Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The flen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor und notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsocition (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

m Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed ·

(A) Under State Laws

(f) "Real Property" In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the flen is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property

subject to the lien is situated; or

With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whonever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) 'Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, ther tangible or Intangible, at the residence of the taxpays at the time the notice of lien is filed,

Fur purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part eish p shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive villos of the business is located; and the residence of a temperyer whose residence is without the United States shall be ut amed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid noted as any other provision of law regarding the form or context of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is refiled In the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such reliting period.

(2) Place For Filling. - A notice of tien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A)

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed; and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiting is entered and recorded in an Index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in) the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located:

(3) Required Refiling Period. -- in the case of any notice of lian, the term frequired refilling period* means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required reliling period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

/a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with raspect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and ac of led by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment come amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extenalon of .uch thief and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to trans, conditions, and form of the bond and suretles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, it a notice of ilen has been liled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
