THE COVENANTS, COUDITION AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE)

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon requises exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
