

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Corle

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any rax neglects or refuees to pay the same after demand, the amount including any interest, additional emount, addition to tax, or assessable pone ly. together with any costs that may accura in addition thereto; shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon et property and rights to property, whather read or personal, beforging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien. --

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the tien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxcayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or personnes unonforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The fien imposed by section 6321 shall not be vaild as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(p) Refilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required rething period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refliing period.

72) Place For Filing.—A notice of tien reflied during the required reflies penos shall be effective only.

(i) such notice of lien is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of from was fired, and

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a cardicate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satished or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the emount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and a unpted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, fogether with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extension o such limb, and that is in accordance with such requirements rewing to forms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies thereof, in may be specified by such requisitions.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Fieturns and Return Information.

W Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—
