

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cuis

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accuse in addition thereto) shall be a flen in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the flent imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such tlability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

ec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against

Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment King Confliction ment Lien Creditors. - The lien Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filled -

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in

which the property subject to the iten is situated; and (ii) Personal Property In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the ludicial district in which the property subject to flor is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, mother tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpaye at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or particish a shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive titler of the buildess is located, and the realdence of a taxpriver whose residence is without the United States shall be or amed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The for a and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Buch notice shall be valid notwart anding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refilling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is refilled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reflling period, such notice of lien shall be troated as liled on. the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period. (1998)

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of then refilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only

(I) such notice of lien, is refiled to the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the race or reliting is entered and recorded in an Index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a reliling of notice of then under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State In which such residence is located:

(3) Required Reflling Period .- in the case of any notice of lien, the term (required rellling period means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding regulted refiling period for such notice of lies.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regula-tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with an interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and excepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extension c such lime), and that is in accordance with such requirements reliant, to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureries thereow, as may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

in Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lian or intends to obtain a right in such property.
