The following is said ordinance as passed:

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to vairant the vacation of public after described in the following ordinance, now therefore.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. That all that part of the east-west 15-foot public alley lying north of the north line of Lot 27; lying south of the south line of Lot 37, both inclusive; lying east of a line drawn from the northwest corner of Lot 27 to the southwest corner of Lot 37, and lying west of a line drawn from the northwest corner of Lot 27 to the southeast corner of Lot 34 all in Block I in (D. M. Hambleton's) Subdivision of Lot E of Circuit Court Partition of the northwest quarter of Section 3. Township 39 North, Range 14 East of the Third Principal Meridian, and subdivision of Block I of same; said public lifely herein vacated being further described as all of the east-west 15-foot public alley running east from North Elizabeth Street a distance of 100 feet in the block bounded by West Hubbara Screet, West Kinzie Street, North Elizabeth Street and North Racine Street as colored in red and indicated by the words "To Be Vacated" on the drawing hereto attached, which drawing for greater certainty, is hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed, inasmuch as the same is no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation.

SECTION 2. The City of Chicago hereby reserves for the benefit of Commonwealth Edison Company, their successors or assigns, an easement to operate, maintain, construct, replace, and renew overhead poles, wires, and associated equipment, and underground conduit, cables and associated equipment for the transmission and distribution of electric energy under, over, and along all of the public alley as herein vacated with the right of ingress and egress.

SECTION 3. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the American National Bank and Trust Company, as Trustee. Trust Number 105255.09 and the Chicago and Northwestern Transportation Company shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owner of the property abutting said public alley hereby vacated, the sum of Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$13,985.00), which sum in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits, and further, shall within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, deposit in the City Truscury of the City of Chicago a sum sufficient to defray the costs of removing paving and curb returns and constructing sidewalk and curb in North Elizabeth Street. The precise amount of the sum so deposited shall be ascertained by the Commissioner of Public Works after such investigation as is requisite.

SECTION 4. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance, the American National Bank and Trust Company, as Trustee, Trust Number 105255-09 and the Chicago and Northwestern Transportation Company shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by the Superintendent of Maps

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
