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

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code part

## Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessible penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tevor of the United States upon all property and rights to properly, whether real artaneound, balancing to such person.

## Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date in epicklically fixed by law, the tien into posed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so essed (or a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such Rability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien cripdity until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in autoection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property " in the case of real property, in one sition within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is skushed; and 157 (ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal prop-

erty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the iten is effurited; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the clark (the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to here is situated, whenever the State has not by lew designated one office which meets the requirements

of autoparagraph (A), or With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is altuated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of peragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, when or tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purp sea of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or parin, who shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive or licy of the business is located, and the residence of a territory whose residence is without the United States shall be de med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The for a and content of the notice referred to in expection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notinity and ng any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflect in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required raffing period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on le on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of ten reflect during the required refling period shall be effective only -

- (R) in the case of real property, the fact of refling is seed and recorded in an index to the extent required by

Secretary received written information (in the marrier payscribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerni a change in the texpeyer's residence, if a notice of such ligh is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of sen, the term "required retting period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the asset ement of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the supiration of 6 boined griller betuper gnibecerq ett in eeck ett a for each notice of ten.

> Sec. 6325, Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may precribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Limbility Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unerstorosable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and a copied by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment The amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof with: the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such ime), and that is in accordance with such requireway to tarme, conditions, and form of the bond and sursties thereor, ar may be specified by such regulations.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding sien.-If a notice of ien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such fien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
