

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Corie

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refutes to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together ith any costs that may accrue in addition therato) shall be a tian in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Sability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section

6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## m Place For Filing Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Rest Property - in the case of real property, in one A office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal prop erty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

Columbia

(2) Shus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For pur ose t of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or pertraction chall be deemed to be the place at which the princloal executive affice of the business is located, and the real dence of a 127 year whose residence is without the United States shall be dismed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The ir in an content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be pre-cribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwitt stan ling any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (a) Refling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule, Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiting period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) II-

(i) such notice of lien is relied in the office in which the prior notice of een was filled, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner trascribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of each Sen is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is accused.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regular tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of ratease of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the facility for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

lecativ unantorosable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and a te pled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such (mr.), and that is in accordance with such requirements revery to same, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereou, an may be specified by such regulations.
