

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against

Certain Persons. (a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security In-

terests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgo Sment Lien Creditors. — The Ben Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor, or judgment fien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n Place For Filling Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one chice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Personal Property In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated; or

With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deede Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. the properly subject to the lien is situated in the District of States shall be duemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The fc m and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwith tank ind any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required rafiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiting period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of tien refited during the required reliting period shall be effective only -

(A) If-

- (i) such notice of fien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a reffling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the a change in the taxpayer's residence, # a notice of such fein is also filled in secondance with subsection (f) in the State

of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the precuding required reilling period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such requiretions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shell issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all inlerest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and ac exted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the empired assessed, together with all interest in rethereof within the time prescribed by lew (including any extension of with my) and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to erms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereou, Pa may be epecified by such regulations.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien.-If a notice of lien has been filed purpuent to section 8323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lies may be displaced to any person who turnishes estisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intende to obtain a right in such property.
