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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

- 1. Mertgagers shall (3) premptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged of the 'destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgages; (4) complete within a responsible time any suitdings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by link or municipal ordinance.
- Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagore duplicate receipts therefor, To provent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors May desire to contest.
- 3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien therein, or imposing upon the Mirtgages the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or changes or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgages or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgages's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagers, upon demand by the Mortgages, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgage therefor, provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgages as it might be unlawful to require Mortgagers to make such payment or (b) the making or such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by faw, then and in such event, the Mortgagers, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable Sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.
- 4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect or the issuance of the note. Yet y secured, the Mortgagors covenant and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagors further covenant to hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Mortgagoe, and the Mortgagoe's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any lax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.
- 5. At such time as the Mo tge jors are not in default either under the terms of the note secured nereby or under the terms of this mortgage, tre Mortgagors shall have such privillers of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.
- 4. - 12. Upon or at any time after the filling of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filled may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insplicancy of Mortgagers at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the premises or whether the same shall be then escaped as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect therents, issues and prefits of said gremises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of recemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled the cellect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, pessession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period.
